'95-' 98Chevrolet/GMC CK, Suburban, Yukon, or Tahoe Mirror INSTALL ATION INSTUCTIONS

(Replaces manual or electric models OEN mirror)

- 1. Using the Trim Panel Remover Tool(supplied), carefully remove the mirror access panel at the upper front of the interior door panel. This is attached to the door with a single retainer that is located near the top of fine panel. Gently pull the panel out at the top until clip clears the sheet metal and then lift panel out.
- 2. Remove the noise insulator foam that is covering the mirror retaining nuts. Save it for re installation.
- 3. Carefully disconnect the power harness from the vehicle (if applicable on your model)
- 4. It is helpful to have someone holding up the mirror you are removing at this point. Using the 10mm wrench and socket, remove the three attaching nuts. (NOTE: It is best to cover the opening below the mirrors attaching nuts (w/a rag or something like that) to prevent the nuts from falling down inside the door when removed.
- 5. Place your new CIPA mirror into position and attach the three nuts supplied. Tighten to 53 inch pounds (6N.m), or snug as possible.
- 6. Replace the noise insulator foam piece.
- 7. Reattach the access cover on the door.

Tools Needed

10mm box end wrench.
10mm deep socket and ratchet wrench.
Trim Panel Remover Tool (supplied)
