1. Preparing Vehicle

- a. Make sure vehicle is parked on level surface.
- b. Set parking brake.
- c. If engine has run in the past two hours, let it cool down.
- f. Do not discard stock components after removal.

2. Removal of stock Components



a. Remove the plastic clip and 10mm bolt shown on both the driver and passenger sides above the front strut tops.



b. Remove the 10mm bolt and two 14mm nuts securing the strut bracket on both front strut tops



c. Remove the black mounting brackets on each strut top location.

3. Installation of AEM Strut Bar



a. Use the two 14mm nuts previously removed to secure the AEM strut bar as shown.



b. Reinstall the plastic clip and 10mm bolt to fasten down the upper plastic fascia.



c. AEM Strut Bar installed.

AEM will not honor this warranty due to mechanical damage (i.e. improper installation or fitment), damage from misuse, or accidents. AEM will not warrant its powder coating if the finish has been cleaned with a hydrocarbon-based solvent. The powder coating should only be cleaned with a mild soap and water solution. Proof of purchase of the AEM Strut Tower Bar is required for redemption of a warranty claim.

This warranty is limited to the repair or replacement of the AEM part. In no event shall this warranty exceed the original purchase price of the AEM part nor shall AEM be responsible for special, incidental or consequential damages or cost incurred due to the failure of this product. Warranty claims to AEM must be transportation prepaid and accompanied with dated proof of purchase. This warranty applies only to the original purchaser of product and is nontransferable. Improper use or installation, or an accident, abuse, unauthorized repairs or alterations voids this warranty. AEM disclaims any liability for consequential damages due to breach of any written or implied warranty on all products manufactured by AEM. Warranty returns will only be accepted by AEM when accompanied by a valid Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) number. Credit for defective products will be issued pending inspection. Product must be received by AEM within 30 days of the date RMA is issued.
