No more than 30mm of spacer can be placed between the stem and the top cap of the 3D system. The headset expander plug must be placed directly at the same height at the stem steerer clamping, or else it will void the efficiency of the compressor. These practices will automatically cancel any warranty claim against the manufacturer.



When uninstalling the headset cap, you need to first loosen the headset cap, remove the HS cap screw and remove the fork from the frame. Then you need to pinch the rear section the headset cap and lift the rear section upward. This will release the headset cap from the frame.

Here are the basic bike-fitting steps to follow before proceeding with the complete assembly.

Consult your authorized Argon 18 Dealer to assure a proper fit that takes into account your personal specifications.

STEP 1: Frame Size

• Using the Sizing Chart (p.6), determine the required frame size based on your saddle height measurement. Where two frame sizes are suggested, you can choose depending on your prefered stack, reach and stand-over clearance.

STEP 2: Saddle Height

• The seat post might need to be cut-to-size depending on your required saddle height. Refer to Min/Max Seat Post Insertion instructions (p.7).

STEP 3: Stack Height

• Using the Sizing Chart's Stack and Reach columns (p.6), determine the required 3D system headset size (0mm, 15mm or 30mm) based on your recommended handlebar position.

STEP 4: Reach

• Each Krypton Pro frameset include a size specific stem:

• If the handlebar reach needs to be adjusted to acheive your required position, the other stem lengths are available separately. Refer to the Annex A. Stem Swap Kits instructions (p.35).

• A total of 60mm of stack adjustment is possible.

• Using the Sizing Chart's Stack and Reach columns (p.6), determine the required 3D system headset size (Omm, 15mm or 30mm) based on your recommended handlebar position.

• 30mm of profiled spacers are provided to finetune your position:

(2x) Spacer 5mm (7.7)

(2x) Spacer 10mm (7.8)

1. Spacers must be installed with the **tabs facing upward.** This feature ensure proper alignement with the stem and between each spacer.

2. Open and slide-on the required spacers over the front side of the steerer. Integrated tabs also guide the spacers on the steerer tube's front rib.

3. Twist-lock each spacer over the steerer tube and stack them up between the headset Stack Compressor (a.) and the Stem's 1st Spacer (7.3).

- Flat eccentric compressor cap* (a.)
- Flat Head Screw M5x50mm* (b.)
- Eccentric Top Spacer (7.9)

*parts of the Argon18 HeadSet No.30/Kit2 (4.4)

IMPORTANT: In all configuration, it is critical to assemble the headset expander plug (b.) at the same height as the Stem's steerer clamp.



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To assemble the Krypton Pro Stem with the Integrated Top Compression Cap (7.5), the fork's steerer tube must be cut-to-size.

1. Confirm your desired stack height and stem height position. **Measure twice, cut once!**

2. Mark the top-back-end of the stem's carbon body (7.1).

3. Mark the cut line 3-4mm lower than the stem's top-back-end mark.

4. Cut the fork's steerer tube using a standard steerer tube cutting jig and a carbon-specific blade.

5. File down the cut end of the steerer to make sure it is free of burr.

HEALTH & SAFETY WARNING

The carbon fibers can easily become a fine dust during cutting or mechanical finishing and can then be released into the surrounding atmosphere. These micro fibers if uncontrolled have a potential to stick into human skin or the mucous membranes causing irritation.

Wear respiratory protection, gloves, eye protection and keep skin covered.

You should also work in a well-ventilated space away from electrical equipment. Carbon fiber is conductive; if airborne carbon fiber dust or off-cuts penetrate into electrical switches or equipment, short circuits or electric shock may occur.

When cutting carbon fiber composite, minimise dust or particulate generation by:

- wet processing of the material;
- using non-powered hand tool.



Steps of assembly

- 1. Insert the headset plastic sleeve into the top on the headtube. (apply grease)
- 2. Insert the required headset column, 0, 15 or 30mm, in the headset plastic sleeve. (apply grease)
- *** After Step 2., complete the frame cable routing before continuing with Step 3. Refer to section 6. or 7. ***
- 3. Insert bottom bearing on the fork.
- 4. Slide the fork in the head tube of the frame.
- 5. Install top bearing in the headset column. (apply grease)
- 6. Install conical compressor ring.
- 7. Install stack compressor.
- 8. Apply grease on the headset seal to avoid any noise.
- 9. Install the corresponding headset cap to complete the assembly.
- 10. Fix the cap with the M4 flat head screw.







1. Select the correct rear derailleur hanger depending on the type of derailleur that you have.

a. Direct mount

2. Make sure to align the rear derailleur hanger.

Depending of the type of assembly, you will have to select the correct parts.

Tip: No matter the type of assembly you will choose, always pass the brake housing first starting from the back of the bike to the front.

1. With the rear brake housing coming from the back of the bike, guide the end of the housing through the top of the head tube opening.

2. Use the brake housing to insert the foam liner into the downtube.

3. Guide the Di2 cable coming from the shifters through the top of the head tube and out of the rectangular opening of the console.

4. Guide the Di2 cable coming from the derailleurs into the downtube and out of the rectangular opening of the console.

5. Place the Di2 O-Ring around the Shimano EW-RS910 junction box.

6. Connect the shifters and derailleurs Di2 cables to the Shimano EW-RS910 junction box.

7. Clip the Shimano EW-RS910 junction box on the console cap.

8. Fix the console cap to the downtube of the frame with the screws.

For Wireless groupset, simply fix the Wireless Console Cover to the downtube of the frame with the screws.

- 3D+ system Headset w/ specific expander (4.4)
- HT Top cap, in 3 sizes: 0mm (4.1), 15mm (4.2), 30mm (4.3)
- Spacers: 2x 5mm (7.7) + 2x 10mm (7.8)
- Stem 1st Spacer (7.3)
- Stem Carbon Body (7.1)
- Stem Cable/Hoses Hood (7.2)
- Stem Bar Clamp (7.4)
- Steerer Compression Cap (7.5)
- Flat Head Screw M5x25mm (7.6)
- Stem's Steerer clamp screws, 2x Socket Head M5x20mm w/ captive spherical washer (7.10)
- Stem's Handlebar clamp screws, 4x Socket Head M5x14mm w/ captive spherical washer (7.11)

Note: The IST system allows for 2cm of adjustment range in stack / reach without having to bleed the brakes, and accepts all standard handlebars of Ø31.8mm.

Stem lengths available: 70mm, 80mm, 90mm, 100mm, 110mm and 120mm.



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Stem Assembly - Step #1

After completion of the frame's internal cable routing (refer to section 6. or 7.), you will have two cable / hose coming out of the HT:

- Rear brake hydraulic housing (BR)
- Di2 cable (EW)

Note: Make sure the cable and hose are not pulled too much inside the frame. Leave some spare length by slightly pushing back a few cm length of cable / hose. This can help later to better adjust the fit when changing the stack height or reach length without having to rebleed the system.

Stem Assembly - Step #2

1. Prepare the fork by routing the front brake hose thru the inside of the left blade, out of the left-side hole in the steerer (use the right-side hole if you are assembling the front brake on the right-side lever).

2. Bolt on the front brake caliper to the fork.

3. Complete the Headset installation (see p.11), taking care to guide the brake hoses and Di2 cables into the steerer tube's grooves.



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Stem Assembly - Step #3

1. Install spacers, if required (refer the Stack Height Adjustment instructions, p.8).

2. Thread the cable / hoses into the 1st Spacer and slide the 1st Spacer onto the steerer tube.

3. Install the Stem Carbon Body onto the steerer tube. Apply grease on the M5x20 screws (7.10) and slightly tighten just to hold the stem in place, 1 cm above the 1st spacer.

4. Install the HS expander plug into the steerer tube, putting cabon fiber assembly paste on the outside surface of the expander plug. **Torque at 10Nm**.

5. Install the chosen Top Cap (refer to p.9).

6. Carefully position the brake hoses on each side and the Di2 cable in the middle of the stem / 1st spacer recesses and slowly screw the Top Cap screw. **Torque at 3Nm.**

7. Align the Stem and tighten the M5x20 screws. **Torque at 5Nm**.

IMPORTANT: In all configuration, it is critical to assemble the headset expander plug (b.) at the same height as the Stem's steerer clamp.



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1. Thread the cable / hoses into the Cables/ hoses Hood (7.2).

The Molecule must be placed at the top-front position.

2. Slide the Hood over the Stem's Carbon Body, enough to clear the handlebar and the bar clamp.





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Stem Assembly - Step #5

1. Install the Bar Clamp (7.4) using the 4 M5x14mm Screws (7.11). Apply grease on the screw threads and only engage all screw threads.

- 2. First, tighten the top screws. Torque at 5Nm.
- 3. Second, tighten the bottom screws. **Torque at 5Nm**.

4. Pull back the Hood over the top screws and insert the Hood's tab into the Bar Clamp groove.

Note: There must be no gap between the Bar Clamp and the Stem Carbon Body after torquing the Top Screws. The gap will be at the front (bottom screws).







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Stem Assembly - Step #6

Complete the cable / hoses routing into the handlebar and shifters according to the manufacturer's recommendations.

1. Select the corresponding chain catcher. The selection of the correct chain catcher is made in function of the size of the small chaining.

Small Chain Ring Size	Chain Catcher

2. Insert the screw in the chain catcher and place the lock washer between the frame and the piece. Secure the assembly loosely to be able to adjust the parts.

3. Place the tip of the chain catcher at approximately 2mm to the inner side of the small chain ring. And torque at 3Nm.





i. According to the model of fender using place the backet at the correct hight on the seatstay.

ii. Secure the fender braket with the 2 attached rubber band making sure that the 2 plastic parts are well over lapping.

iii. When securing the fender on your seatstay, make sure that the screw is not longer than 12mm.

KRYPTON PRO 302A ANNEX B. Tips for Traveling with a Bike Box

ARGON 18



Integrated cables can sometimes present a challenge when packing a bike for travel, but this is not the case with the Krypton Pro. The entire cockpit can be removed as one piece and attached to the frame within a box or bike bag, in the same way as a regular cockpit and cables.

Tips: in some bike box, it is better to turn the fork 180°. To obtain more loose brake housing length, the spacers can be removed and the brake calipers unmounted. The stem can also be removed if needed.

1. Install brake caliper pads for transportation

2. Install a rear axle (depending on the bike box, to protect the rear drop-out)

3. Unscrew the stem's Top Cap and the two Stem's steerer clamp screws

4. Roll up the cable hood and remove the Stem from the steerer

5. Protect the frame and attach the handlebar to the frame's top tube

6. Install the bike in the bike box, according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Re-assembly steps:

- 1. Put back the spacers and HS assembly
- 2. Tighten all stem screw and torque at 5Nm
- 3. Enjoy the ride!
