Vineyard & Harvest

The 2007 growing season started with bud break in mid March after a cool and dry winter. With the lack of rainfall, vine canopies were below normal vigor which produced small clusters with tiny berries. Temperatures during the growing season were very calm and consistent making it possible to harvest at the optimum maturity producing our best vintage yet.

The History

Sorelle per Sempre has been a family favorite since the first vintage. Roughly translated to "Sisters Forever" in Italian, this wine was originally named after Matt Donati's daughters.

Aging

100% Barrel Aged; 15% New French Oak, 85% Neutral French Oak

Tasting Notes

Aroma: Oak toast, jam and spice.

Palate: Rich tannin and soft acid finishing with bright

cherry fruit.

6% Cabernet Sauvignon
