

DOUBLE HAPPINESS CABINET



As a western person, Chinese writing looks like an aggregation of symbols. Some are aesthetically more pleasing than others, some even more so in their balance. Since so much of Chinese communication is also expressed through symbols, I decided to focus on one particularly balanced and with a positive message: double happiness. Hence the birth of this cabinet. Made of recovered elm from beams that once held up a structure, and sculpted with allegoric rock and roll style hatted skulls, held together without glues but by century old traditional Chinese joinery, this represents my marriage between East and West, ancient and modern. All the measurements are related to the naturally occurring Fibonacci sequence, universal in Nature.
