Accessing Funding for Family Training

Family Training:

Training services for the family of an individual to increase capabilities of the family to care for support and maintain the individual in the home.

Services are provided by in organized conferences and workshops that are limited to topics related to the individual's disability, identified support needs, or specialized medical or habilitation support needs.

- Oregon Intervention Systems training when an approved BSP indicates the training would be beneficial.
- Instruction about treatment regimens and use of equipment specified in the Individual Support Plan
- Information, education and training about the individual's disability, medical, and behavioral conditions.
- Training to safely manage challenging behavior.

Pre-requisite: Any individual qualified for services through the Community Developmental Disabilities Program who is receiving Comprehensive Waiver funded supports through K-plan are eligible to access family training.

How to access funding:

1. Talk with your service coordinator to ensure you are eligible for family training.
2. Schedule a meeting to review your individual support plan.
3. Complete change form to request family training to be added to the service plan.
4. Obtain confirmation from SC that family training is approved.
5. Register for training and send invoice to SC.
6. SC will request payment for training on behalf of individual participant.
