# MID-PENINSULA WATER DISTRICT (MPWD) ELECTS NEW BOARD PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT

## *Betty Linvill takes the helm as president; sets course for 2015*

BELMONT, CA (February, 2015) – The MPWD has elected new leadership for its 2015 Board of Directors. Betty L. Linvill, an MPWD Board member since 2007, assumes her role as president while Matt Zucca, an MPWD Board member since 2005, will serve as vice president.

During the Board's recent strategic planning session, and in response to the statewide emergency drought, President Linvill acknowledged that "MPWD customers responsively stepped up to the call for conservation and reduced their water usage by 16% in 2014." The extended dry weather conditions into 2015 makes water conservation a paramount issue and presents many challenges for the MPWD Board of Directors and staff. "We will continue our public outreach to keep customers informed," announced President Linvill.
