This permit modification is issued in accordance with section 22a-430 of Chapter 446k, Connecticut General Statutes ("CGS"), section 22a-430-4(p)(5) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies ("RCSA") adopted thereunder, as amended, and Section 402(b) of the Clean Water Act, as amended 33 USC 1251, <u>et</u>. <u>seq</u>., and pursuant to an approval dated September 26, 1973, by the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency for the State of Connecticut to administer a N.P.D.E.S. permit program.

The Commissioner of Environmental Protection ("the Commissioner") has made a final determination on this permit modification and found that modification of the existing system or installation of a new system will protect the waters of the state from pollution. The Commissioner's decision is based on Application No. 201005765 for permit modification received on September 22, 2010 and the administrative record established in the processing of that application.

Ansonia Copper and Brass, Inc., ("Permittee"), shall comply with all conditions of Permit No. CT0002968 issued on March 22, 2006 and modified on December 1, 2008 with the following modifications:

- 1. With respect to the compliance schedule, Sections 9(B)(6) and 9(G) of NPDES Permit No. CT0002968 issued March 22, 2006 and modified on December 1, 2008, are hereby revised and superseded to read as follows:
 - 9(B)(6) Implementation of Approved Actions. The Permittee shall perform the approved actions in accordance with the approved schedule, **but in no event shall the approved actions be completed later than March 20, 2011**. Within fifteen (15) days after completing such actions, the Permittee shall certify to the Commissioner in writing that the actions have been completed as approved.
 - 9(G) <u>Submission of documents.</u> Any document, other than a discharge monitoring report, required to be submitted to the Commissioner under this section of the permit shall, unless otherwise specified in writing by the Commissioner, be directed to:

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The Commissioner hereby authorizes the Permittee to discharge in accordance with the provisions of this permit modification, Permit No. CT0002968, the above referenced application, and all approvals issued by the Commissioner or the Commissioner's authorized agent for the discharges and/or activities authorized by, or associated with, this permit.

The Commissioner reserves the right to make appropriate revisions to the permit in order to establish any appropriate effluent limitations, schedules of compliance, or other provisions that may be authorized under the Clean Water Act or the Connecticut General Statutes or regulations adopted thereunder, as amended. The permit as modified under this paragraph may also contain any other requirements of the Clean Water Act or Connecticut General Statutes or regulations adopted thereunder which are then applicable.

All other terms and conditions of Permit No. CT0002968 issued on March 22, 2006 and modified on December 1, 2008 shall continue in full force and effect.
