| PE Apprenticeship April to October | £1745.00 | Apprentice to support with delivery of PE lessons, support with after school clubs and extra-curricular activities involving sport, leading to improved participation and engagement in PE and Sport. |
| Schemes of Work - Val Sabin | £545.00 | New Scheme of works for teachers to use alongside other schemes to create a medium term plan which they are confident to use to teach high quality PE lessons. |
| Burnside CPD Support | £760.00 | Continued CPD from Burnside focusing on developing the skills of teachers in Gymnastics, Dance and Handball and thus improving quality of provision for pupils. |
| Change for Life Sports Club Training | £70.00 | Change 4 Life Training, Sports Leader training and extra co-ordinator administration. Change for Life Club runs weekly to engage and inspire pupils who are less engaged and active in sport. |
| Newcastle United Foundation Premier League CPD | £500.00 | Specialist Coaches work alongside Teachers delivering PE lessons to enhance the quality of provision for pupils. |
| Sports Leader Training | £120.00 | An increase in the active number of Sports Leaders to 30 pupils and a new committee to run and organise events in school, which will continue to develop further. |
| Transport for Competitions | £700.00 | Transportation for pupils to take part in tournaments, events and festivals, developing positive attitudes and engagement. |
| Healthy School Plus training | £140.00 | CPD for two members of staff on Healthy School Plus Training to enhance curriculum. |
| Newcastle United Foundation Lunchtime & After School Activities | £1000.00 | NUF Specialist Coaches running clubs at lunchtime and after school to show pupils specific skills and games. Giving the pupils the skills to run some of the clubs themselves improving their confidence and motivation. |
| Newcastle United Foundation Breakfast Club | £200.00 | New Breakfast Club in school, which has continued after the launch, giving pupils access to sport before school and a greater sense of belonging. |
| Davies Sports PE Equipment | £1596.00 | New equipment to ensure the continuation of quality lessons for the new curriculum increasing motivation of pupils and staff. |
| Other sports events, equipment and training | £517.00 | Equipment replenishment, attendance at sport festivals and training to improve the skills of staff and pupils. |
