

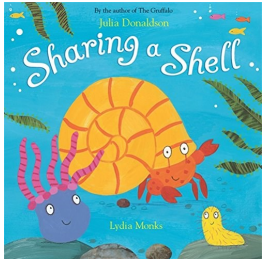
# Nursery News
