

Our topic in Year 5 this term is 'The First World War'.

We will be finding out about key events between 1914 and 1918, focusing upon their impact upon those left on the Home Front and investigating the men who made up 'Footballer's Battalion'.

In Science, we will be investigating living things and their habitats and animals including humans.



Year 6 will be exploring the development of cinema and its impact upon British culture and society over the past 100 years.

Linking with this, we will also be taking part in the Tyneside Cinema's Time Machine project, including a visit to the venue in Newcastle.

In Science, we will be investigating aspects of light and electricity.
