Introduction to Design Cultures	Design History, History of Furniture Design, History of Interiors, Design Appreciation (seminar/lecture based not fieldtrip based.)
Forms of Writing	Any college level writing course, AP English with exam score of 3 or higher.
History of the Universe and Science	History of Science and Technology, Cosmology, Philosophy of Science
Film I	Film studies, literature courses that include film
Art History I	Art History from Prehistory to 1900, Humanities from Prehistory to 1900, Art Appreciation
Art Histroy II	Art History from 20th century to Contemporary, Art Theory
History of Architecture I	Architecture survey course covering Prehistoric to Renaissance.
History of Architecture II	Architecture survey course covering Renaissance to 1945.
History of Architecture III	Architecture survey covering 1945-Present
Philosophy I	Introduction to Philosophy, Ancient Greek Philosophy, Classics, Continental Philosophy
Contemporary Civilization	Western Civilization, Media Studies
New Models of Nature and Biology	Theory of Ecology, Biology, AP Biology (with test scores of 3 or higher), Natural or Life Sciences
Liberal Studies Elective (3 courses)	Any course in social science, natural science or applied science.
