In his last role as VP of Global Retail Innovation, he led the creation of Nike's first Nike Live concept, an innovative, connected shopping experience which won Retail Concept of the Year. Prior to Nike, Merritt held a leadership role at the design and innovation firm IDEO.

Of his new role as SCI-Arc Trustee, Merritt shares, "SCI-Arc was a pivotal part of my early creative journey and was foundational in allowing me to push the boundaries of where an education in architecture could take one. I am honored and excited to come back to SCI-Arc in a capacity to help shape its next chapter, and I look forward to getting to know and working with my fellow board members, faculty, staff, and students."
