

METHODOLOGY

- DATA COLLECTION: SLO County Residents 18 +
 - 400 phone interviews / 20K phone #s/2,500 contacts
 - Completed November 2014
 - Landlines and cell phones
 - 5% margin of error at 95% confidence level at county level
 - Distributed across county's four main regions consistent with population distribution in county
 - North County = 34%
 - South County = 28%
 - San Luis Obispo (city) = 24%
 - North Beaches = 14%
 - Stratified: sample demographics = county demographics
- DATA ANALYSIS
 - Primary analysis: Total county and county's four regions
 - Secondary analysis: Gender, age, education and ethnicity
 - 2008 data comparison

Q: What is your perception of the local air quality? Would you say it is very good, good, fair or poor?




PERCEPTIONS OF LOCAL AIR QUALITY






AIR QUALITY -- CHANGES OVER TIME

Q: Would you say local air quality has gotten better, stayed the same or gotten worse over time?




IMPORTANCE OF GOOD AIR QUALITY

Q: On scale of 1 to 10..., how important do you believe good air quality is to your health and lifestyle and that of your family?




CONCERN ABOUT PROTECTING AIR QUALITY

Q: On scale of 1 to 10..., how concerned are you about protecting local air quality?




CONCERN ABOUT CLIMATE CHANGE

Q: On scale of 1 to 10..., how important is good AQ...? How concerned are you about protecting local AQ? How concerned are you with climate change?




AIR QUALITY AND CLIMATE CHANGE

Q: How concerned are you about protecting air quality? ...climate change?




MOST MOTIVATING FACTORS


Q: I am going to read some things that sometimes motivate people.... For each, please tell me if it would motivate you a lot, a little or not at all...?

Family member is diagnosed with a heart or lung condition	53%








AWARENESS OF AIR POLLUTION ISSUES

Q: Are you aware of any particular air pollution issues in San Luis Obispo County?




FAMILIARITY WITH APCD

Q: How familiar are you with the San Luis Obispo County Air Pollution Control District...? Very, somewhat, a little familiar or never heard of them?




FAMILIARITY WITH APCD
