An ocean source of planktonic and related bacterial PM10 is potentially far greater than other sources because the area of ocean surface where phytoplankton blooms occur offshore from Oceano Dunes is tens of thousands of acres larger than the OHV riding area of the State Park" and also stating "Nearby coastal seawater is contributing biological material to PM10 aerosols (10 microns or less) detected and captured inland at monitoring sites using EBAMs. This likely includes whole microbes, ranging from the one micron sized bacteria to small eukaryotes less than 10 microns such as small diatoms."

Now i'm no scientist but it seems to me that the particulate mater is from other sources that are out of our control and not within the OHV park, I am completely disgusted in how dishonest and corrupt the Coastal Commissioners, Air pollution control district, the Air Pollution Control Officer and i'm sure there are many others that fit into the category regarding this matter.
