I urge the SLO APCD Hearing Board to reject the latest draft Stipulated Order of Abatement and to draft their own order. Once again, State Parks has been unwilling to set specific abatement objectives and timeframes for achieving them. It makes a mockery of State Parks managers' assurances that the Department is committed to solving the PM pollution problem caused by off-highway vehicle operation on the dunes. The State Parks bureaucrats cannot be trusted to protect public health above recreation without strong oversight and control by the Hearing Board. The draft order does not accomplish this.

Failure to achieve real and significant reduction in PM10 over the next three to four years is the greatest threat to the viability of the OHV. Strong action by the Hearing Board is critical to protecting the public health and protecting the value the Oceano Dune's OHVRA brings to the community.
