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My dad took me to the dunes since the 70's. My 6 month old son already loves the dunes. "Pismo" has been a way of life for many families for a long long time.

It is very clear that the motivation to shrink and eventually close the dunes is based on lies and corruption. From secret meetings with developers to bogus air quality studies, this battle has been a sham for years.

We've all seen the dust storms. Wind makes the dunes. Wind blows the sand around. ATVs hardly use the dunes on really windy days and the sand blows around like crazy anyway. We've all been right there in the middle of it and we've seen the effect of high winds in the area. It is the same effect whether we are there or not. It is the same effect in all the dunes that are already closed. Miles and miles of dunes shaped by the wind. Blaming the ATVs for the sand in the air is absurd.
