State Parks Annual Report and Work Plan (ARWP), is unacceptable; essentially because a "Plan" is lacking. And several 2019 planned actions STILL have not been completed.

Deadlines are missing. Mitigation is "temporary." There is too much focus on the CDF monitor, ignoring other monitors.

After two plus years, the ARWP questions whether the emissions target of the Stipulated Order of Abatement is achievable or even appropriate. Clearly this is yet another delay tactic, and it is deeply troublesome the comment is in the report.

The statement, "minimizing impacts to public recreation opportunities" is bizarre for at least three reasons. 1) This is not a goal of the SOA. 2) When the massive OHVs are present, commandeering the beach, it is clearly single use, and certainly not multiple opportunities for the public. And 3) A better statement reads, "minimizing air pollution hazards in order to protect public health."
