It is my understanding that a settlement has been agreed to between San Luis Obispo County Air Pollution Control District and State Parks, and there is a meeting coming up next week to discuss this proposal. Based on the information provided, it sounds like further investigation is needed before an informed decision can be made. Specifically, to investigate the validity of silica coming from State Vehicular Recreational Areas (SVRA), what impact marine biological material coming from the ocean has on all the air monitoring data and what percentage of dust is coming from the SVRA.

We have been blessed to have been visiting Pismo for 50+ years. We do not want to see this beautiful recreational area closed and hope you will consider this argument against going forward with this proposal.
