Please investigate the validity of silica coming from the SVRA and what impact does the marine biological material coming from the ocean have on all the air monitoring data? Ask what percentage of dust is coming from the SVRA?

Until these vital questions are answered, areas of the Oceano Dunes SVRA should not be closed down.

I have not seen conclusive evidence that the dust is specifically coming from riding activity in any study and even the new proposed agreement seems to hint to that fact.
