The Park District has slow rolled their air pollution mitigation effort. It has been clear that Park's never intended to meet their commitment by 2023. To achieve the promised 50% pollution reduction, they would have to finish planting the required 500 acres this year to allow the plants to mature and block the sand dust by the end of 2023. Do not reward their deceit by allowing them a reduced goal which would cause additional health problems for residents.
