To Whom It May Concern:

The goal of the Stipulated Order of Abatement (SOA) for the ODSVRA is to abate the nuisance created by the off-highway vehicle park, because it is a health hazard and it creates exceedances of state standards designed to protect human health.

We encourage the Hearing Board to stay the course with the SOA in its current form, including its initial requirements for dust emission reduction goals and the number of acres needed for mitigation. At this time, this is the most reliable, direct and simple path forward to meeting SOA goals and to meeting the spirit and letter of the law, rules and regulations. Any proposed extension of the Stipulated Order of Abatement term is unacceptable since it would delay compliance with state air quality standards. Again, this is a health issue! We still expect compliance with state air quality standards by the end of 2023.
