JOB PROFILE

Background to the role

One Planet Living (OPL) is a vision and a framework for delivering a genuinely sustainable future. Bioregional developed the framework to systematise the approaches we took to create the BedZED eco-village. We have been delivering groundbreaking One Planet Living projects around the world for 15 years, reaching nearly 630,000 people directly, inspiring millions and demonstrating proven results.

The urgency of the climate and ecological emergency has led Bioregional to re-launch One Planet Living as a more open resource, freely available to many, with a range of supplementary paid services. We are aiming to build a movement.

The ambition is for One Planet Living to be taken up by cities, companies, schools, community groups and citizens around the world via a global network of trained One Planet Living Integrators. One Planet Living will help change-makers to connect with each other and to speak a common, holistic language of sustainability, accessible to all.

Scope of the job

- 1. Scaling One Planet Living and helping to build a movement, working with the Head of OPL, the CEO & other senior staff to build new partnerships and projects.
- 2. Considering the user journey, identifying resources needed and working with the communications team to create them. Identifying human interest stories and impact data.
- 3. Marketing and business development for paid One Planet Living services. Taking a lead with a systematic approach, working with colleagues to develop & write bids.




- 4. Project delivery primarily for the One Planet Cities project. Work with team members on delivery of other OPL projects including workshops and action plans, assisting with the Oxfordshire Greentech network.
- 5. Training in One Planet Living take the lead role in establishing and running the new training programme, in collaboration with One Planet Digital. Support a new community of One Planet Living integrators.
- 6. Fundraising in a support role with the Fundraising Manager and Head of OPL.

Position in organisation

The One Planet Living Partnerships Manager will report to the Head of One Planet Living.

The postholder will liaise closely with the Communications team, the One Planet Living Technical Manager, the business development and fundraising team and with Bioregional's spin out digital platform company, One Planet Digital.



Dimensions and limits of authority

The post has a significant level of authority within the organisation. You will report to the Head of OPL and work strategically with her and other senior team members.
