

Defensive Driver Class Requirements / Eligibility

You may attend a four-hour (DD-4) class if:

1. You have not attended a four-hour defensive driving class in the past five years.
2. You have no more than one moving violation in the past three years.
3. Your driver's license is valid.

PLEASE NOTE: If your citation is for "No Proof of Insurance", or any other non-moving violation, you must show proof of compliance prior to scheduling your class.

If you do not qualify to attend the four-hour class, the eight-hour class (DDC-8) may be an option for you. The eight-hour class is held on Saturdays and is available if you do not qualify for the four-hour class. You must have a valid license and not have attended a previous eight-hour class.

To be eligible for a defensive driver class, you must attend your scheduled court date and request driving school. At that time, a check of your driving history will be conducted and all fees will be due. The Judge will then decide if you are eligible
