



CLASS I—BREEDING SHEEP—Ewe classes must be Registered or Grade Straightbreds. Ewe classes will be shown by breed. All breed winners will be combined for the overall champion and reserve champion.

- Lot 1—Yearling (born after 9/2/14)
- Lot 2—Fall Lamb (9/1/15-12/31/15)
- Lot 3—Early Spring Lamb (1/1/16-1/31/16)
- Lot 4—Late Spring Lamb (after 2/1/16)

CLASS II—MARKET LAMB SHOW—Lambs must have scrapies tag.

- Lot 5—Market Lambs

CLASS III—MARKET SWINE SHOW

- Lot 6—Crossbred Barrow
- Lot 7—Crossbred Gilt
- Lot 8—Purebred Barrow
- Lot 9—Purebred Gilt

CLASS IV—BEEF HEIFER SHOW—Broken into breeds according to the point show regulations.

- Lot 10—Breeding Heifers

CLASS V—STEER & MARKET HEIFER SHOW—Heifers and steers will be broken into breeds according to point show regulations.

- Lot 11—Market Steers
- Lot 12—Market Heifers

CLASS VI—MEAT GOAT SHOW—Scrapie tags required.

- Lot 13—Market Does
- Lot 14—Market Wethers
- Lot 15—Breeding



To be eligible for all Purebred or Registered Market or Breeding Shows (Beef, Breeding Sheep, and Swine), exhibitors are required to show a copy of the registration papers.

PAYBACK

- Beef top 5 breeding heifers and 5 market will have jackpot payback
- Swine top 5 purebred and 5 crossbred will have jackpot payback
- Top 5 market lambs will have jackpot payback
- Top 5 breeding sheep will have jackpot payback
- Top 5 goat market does and 5 market wethers will have jackpot payback
- Top 5 breeding goats will have jackpot payback

This show is open to all South Dakota 4-H members and all those who are eligible for Jr. Points Show. If you are not registered as a Jr. Points member, registration blanks will be available at check in. Points will be awarded for beef, sheep, swine, and meat goat.

4-H ownership rules apply to the animals in the show. Code of Practice must be reviewed and signed by both parent and member and returned with the entry form at registration.

Unethical grooming practices that change the appearance of the animals will not be permitted. Abusing animals in the show ring or in the barn preparing them for the show will not be tolerated. Violation of either rule can mean forfeiture of premiums and the member may be asked to leave the show. (See State 4-H Fair Book for unethical practices.) The committee will be checking for violations.

FITTING & GROOMING: The 4-H exhibitor must be present while washing, clipping, and fitting is being done and during the time the animal is in the Show Ring.

Electricity may be limited so you may consider bringing a generator. If necessary, due to circuit overload, fans will be unplugged. Clippers and blowers take priority. **Must use wood chips—straw will not be allowed except for breeding ewes.**

Livestock will not be released until the end of their show.

No alcohol or camping allowed on the grounds.

All beef animals must be able to tie and lead. Animals that cause problems in the ring and endanger other members will be asked to leave the ring.

All decisions of the show committee, veterinarian, and the judges are final. All livestock must be removed from the barn within 1 hour after the show on Sunday.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

All sheep and meat goats must have a scrapie identification tag in their ear to be eligible for show and this number must be listed on the health certificate.

All animals including: beef, sheep, swine and meat goat must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) and shall have official identification listed on the CVI.

All animals entered at the exhibition shall be free from evidence of all contagious diseases such as ringworm, parasites, pinkeye, lump jaw, abscesses, club lamb fungus, and warts.

ALL South Dakota Health Regulations will be followed.
