Historic Cycles Day: Sunday 11th September 2016

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to enter the next Historic Cycles Day at Amberley Museum. As before, our aim is to stimulate interest in all types of old cycles and cycling history among visitors to the Museum, as well as to provide an enjoyable day for those who have been kind enough to bring along their cycles.

We hope to stimulate the interest of the public not only through the static display of cycles, but also by including a parade. We will notify you on the exact details on this on return of your entry number to be sent two weeks prior to the event date. The wearing of period costume is certainly encouraged but not compulsory.

There is no set age limit for the cycles taking part in this event, but later machines should be of some historic interest. In order to maintain a balanced display it may be necessary for the Museum to restrict the number of some types. Replicas will be considered for entry only if authentic. Entry to the event and the Museum is **free of charge to exhibitors**, partners and up to three children arriving with the exhibit(s). A commemorative programme and attendance sticker will be presented to each entry along with a 'free hot drink' voucher. Any additional passengers will be charged a special discount price of £5 per head, made in advance with your entry from.

The Museum is very grateful for the support of exhibitors for this event, which we're sure, will result in an excellent display. If you would like to take part, please complete and return the entry form opposite. (If entering more than two bicycles please enclose a separate sheet with your entry) a stamped, addressed envelope would be very much appreciated. The **closing date** for applications will be **Friday 12th August**.

Please note that cycles and carrying vehicles **must arrive on site between 8.00am and 9.45am** and cannot leave until 5.00pm. Early arrivals should park in the station car park until 8.00am. All modern vehicles on site will be parked out of sight of the public. We have special parking arrangements for exhibitors with disabilities so please let us know your requirements on your entry form.
