Where did the idea come from?

At a superintendents meeting with 5 of the 6 school districts represented there were ideas of using this facility for hosting job fairs, dairy days, a small scale sportsman show, athletic activities as well as potentially being a disaster area for the Red Cross. There are many different ways this facility would benefit the residents of this county.



Location?

There is no location yet. The first phase of this project is a preliminary study that will assess our county and let us know if this project is feasible and where the best location would be. The only difference would be land being donated.
