The following was written by Rachel Rogovin, LICSW, OSW-C Clinical Social worker at The Tomorrow Fund.

We met Fabio in 2008, when he was first diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia.

Fabio quickly became a fixture at Hasbro Children's Hospital and in The Tomorrow Fund Clinic (due to his outgoing personality and generous spirit). Fabio was a strong advocate for childhood cancer awareness, regularly speaking on behalf of The Tomorrow Fund at fundraising events. Fabio often provided support and encouragement to newly diagnosed patients and was seen as a mentor by his fellow Tomorrow Fund kids. Fabio underwent almost 3 years of chemotherapy treatment and enjoyed a long remission until his relapse earlier last year. Fabio died from his cancer in October 2014.

In 2011, during his senior year of high school, Fabio co-wrote and directed a play about his journey through cancer, along with teacher Moira Carraher. In true Fabio fashion, he donated the ticket proceeds to The Tomorrow Fund and The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. The following is from an excerpt of a story posted on NBC 10, in Fabio's own words:

"It's called 'The Year of the Beginning' because it was the year that I got to start over. I didn't want this to be a play about cancer. I wanted this to be a play about making each day count. It was really therapeutic for me, I can be a funny guy, and I can be a serious person. It has a lot of my personality in it. I could see myself and every time we went through the diagnosis scene, I was cringing and every time I was going on my Make a Wish trip I was happy. All the memories it was bringing back. It was good, bad. And at the end, it was amazing because I got to look at me and I got to look at the person portraying me and it was just perfect."

What does The Tomorrow Fund do when your child gets cancer?

Assist with payment for utilities, mortgages, rents, insurance, co-pays for medicine, etc.

Parking Pass

Hospital parking passes are provided for each family to use throughout the entire length of treatment.

In-House Stipends

\$15 per day is provided to families whenever their child is hospitalized overnight at Hasbro Children's Hospital. Because parents typically stay with their children in the hospital, Stipends are used for meals at the hospital cafeteria, babysitting and transportation. Expenses mount quickly and can easily overwhelm a family, especially those who are already struggling to get by.

Travel Stipend

\$50 per day is provided to families whose children must travel outside of Rhode Island for life saving bone marrow transplants, stem cell transplants and associated protocols. Out of state hospitalization can last a minimum of 30 days, to a typical 100 days, to even more time if there are complications.

What Happens When Your Child Gets Cancer?

DISBELIEF – *This can't be happening to my child.*

How can this be – it's not fair that my child is sick – we're good people – we don't deserve this. Your family life has just become a shambles as you try to go through the motions of everyday life. You know what the test results said, but they have to be wrong. What did the doctor, nurse say? What are they going to do to my child? What do you mean "Chemo" – that just can't be right . . . *Why is this happening to my child?*



PANIC - *What do we do now?*

There are steps to take, but there are no arrows pointing the way. Your family has questions, your child has questions and the answers are out of reach. You just feel numb. There is no control in what is happening to your child. How are we going to cope with all this by ourselves? What about my job? What about the expenses? What about the rest of the family? And then there is . . . *What do we do now?*



CONFUSION – *Who can I talk to?*

There just has to be someone with answers, someone who can explain what is happening. We can't spend our days running in circles with no end in sight. We need help to sort these things out for us – help to make sense of the disaster that has befallen our precious child . . . *Who can I talk to?*

TREATMENT – *Where do we go?*

Where do we take our child for help? Is there a place just for kids with cancer in RI? What about the treatment schedule, doctors and nurses to meet with, medicines to give? Who are the doctors that I'm entrusting my child's life to? Will the nurses be there when I can't be because of my job or extended family needs? . . . *Where do we go?*

SUDDENLY IT HITS . . . *We are never ever ready when bad things happen, especially to our children.*

The Tomorrow Fund is there to provide the monetary and emotional support that is needed when cancer happens to your child.

The Tomorrow Fund is the only independent, non-profit organization based in Rhode Island, providing a comprehensive program of daily, continuing financial and emotional support to children with cancer, survivors, and their families, treated at Hasbro Children's Hospital and diligently striving to ensure access to the highest level of care, while promoting public awareness of childhood cancer.

- Every day, 43 children are diagnosed with cancer in the United States.
- 1 out of 8 of these children will not survive.
- Each year, 40,000 children in the US are in cancer treatment.
- In the last 20 years, only 2 cancer medications have been specifically developed for children.

CAMP DOTTY

Camp Dotty, a day camp for 4-7 year old children with cancer and their siblings, was created to provide a camp experience for young children while recognizing their individual needs as they deal with cancer. The camp helps to create a transition for those children not old enough to attend an overnight camp while simply and importantly giving parents a much needed break. Last year, for the 14th consecutive year, more than 30 children with cancer and their siblings had a respite from their usual hospital routine. They enjoyed a full week of crafts, games, field trips and summertime fun at Camp.

INVESTING IN TOMORROW - KIDS RECEIVE DINO GERMANI COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS
