

SENDING GOODS TO DOMINICA

Relief items for **Government of Dominica** should be consigned to: Office of Disaster Management , Jimmit, Dominica.

To send relief to Dominica **via Rotary** your contributions should be properly packaged and clearly addressed with the following:

For sending items, your labelling must state the sender (Rotary Club of....) and the recipient (Rotary Club of Dominica).

The goods must be accompanied by a Rotary invoice with details of goods, customs value at zero and ERIKA mentioned. All this is mandatory for Rotarians in Dominica to be able to retrieve the goods without paying taxes.

Personal packages may also be sent if you have family in Dominica, in that case write the person's name in care of Rotary Club...

Each package should be marked so as to reduce the chances of them being lost as a result of the displacement which may take place during shipping.
