Did you know?

- Since 1996, Care Corps has served over 8,500 people (over 25% are children)
- Over 15,000 shelter nights provided in 2011
- 52% of school children meet low-income guidelines for the lunch at school program
- 66% of homeless children are raised by single mothers
- Over 80% served are from the Fremont area
- Over 50% of those served are FAMILIES!
- Everyday, 450 people in Fremont are one paycheck away from homelessness.

At Care Corps, adults and children receive the following services:

Prevention Services provide food boxes, clothing, and school supplies

Emergency Shelter provides a safe environment 24-hours a day

Case Management assists clients with employment, housing and healthcare

Healthcare Assistance helps with prescriptions and medical care

Professional Counseling by a licensed mental health/substance abuse counselor

Life Skills Classes teach skills in employment, budgeting & parenting,

Aftercare Services are offered to all clients for up to 6 months after leaving

Transitional Housing assists people who are facing homelessness in obtaining safe and suitable housing



The Origin of Care Corps

The idea of Care Corps came from a group of community leaders that wanted to provide services to assist those suffering from poverty and hunger in our community.

These leaders had the vision for an agency that would help address the underlying causes of homelessness to ensure long-term strength and self-sufficiency of those in crisis.

The current facility is a credit to over 500 local individuals and organizations who committed their time, talent and treasure to a project that will give back to the community for decades to come.
