

UTILITY ISSUED BOIL WATER NOTICE

BOIL YOUR WATER BEFORE USING

On 7/27/2016, a valve repair causing loss of line pressure to some residents has prompted the Kenova Water System to issue a precautionary boil water notification to the residences in the area. The areas that are affected are as follows:

- **Any Customers located on Spring Valley Drive and any subdivisions off of Spring Valley Drive from and to include Meadow Lane towards Route 75.**
- **Any customers located in the Cloverdale extension area of Route 75. This area starts at Spring Valley Drive and goes toward Lavallette.**
- **Any customers located near the areas listed above that has experienced low or absent water pressure.**

Do not drink the water without boiling it first. Bring all water to a boil, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drink, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, bathing, and food preparation **until further notice.** Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.

What happened? What is being done?

Kenova Water repair crews repaired a water main valve in the Meadow Lane area of Spring Valley Drive. We will notify customers when there is no longer any need to boil their water prior to consumption.
