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The Industries of the Transatlantic Economy

An Analysis of Industries Accounting for the Most European-Sourced
Jobs and European-Owned Enterprises in the United States

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Introduction

In *Economic Connections between European Metropolitan Regions and the United States*, the author undertook a first step towards a detailed analysis of transatlantic economic connections on the metropolitan area/region level.¹ Subsequently, in *Transatlantic Economic Connections of Metropolitan Areas in the United States*² and *Transatlantic Economic Connections of European Metropolitan Regions*³, conclusions were reached regarding those U.S. metropolitan areas and European metropolitan regions accounting for the most European-sourced jobs and European-owned enterprises.

This paper looks at transatlantic economic connections from an industry perspective, identifying the most relevant industries for the transatlantic economy as well as describing and explaining industry-specific patterns. The analysis is based on a database compiled by Center for Transatlantic Relations fellow Philip Schnattinger, using data provided by the Brookings Institution for their research on FDI in U.S. metropolitan areas.⁴

'Jobs' in this article refers to jobs directly created by foreign direct investment, not including jobs generated by U.S. exports or imports or indirect employment effects related to distributor and supplier chains, and thereby significantly underestimating the overall total of jobs reliant on commerce with Europe.

Part 1: European-Sourced Jobs and European-Owned Enterprises by Industry

In Table 1, the twenty-five industries that account for the most European-sourced jobs in the United States are listed, including the respective percentages of all European-sourced jobs.

The industries listed in Table 1 account for 47.85% (1,501,767 of 3,138,408) of all European-sourced jobs in the United States; the industries listed in Table 2 account for 56.44% (31,910 of 56,541) of all European-owned enterprises in the United States.⁵



Consequentially, industries analyzed in this paper represent a significant portion of transatlantic economic connections with regard to both jobs and enterprises.

Part 2: Analysis of Individual Industries

In Part 2, a detailed analysis of the industries described in Part 1 is conducted. First, for every industry listed in Tables 1 and 2, the twenty-five metropolitan/micropolitan region/area pairs that account for the most European-sourced jobs (see Table 3) and European-owned enterprises (see Table 4) will be identified.⁶ Second, for every industry, the source regions and destination areas responsible for the most jobs and enterprises will be determined (see Table 5). Third, for all thirty-nine industries (see below), transatlantic connection patterns will be described and, if possible, analyzed and explained.⁷





Percentage of jobs sourced from Brussels, Amsterdam, and Cambridge






Percentage of jobs sourced from Stockholm and Oxford-South East




Jobs in the Los Angeles MSA as a percentage of European-sourced jobs









Percentage of jobs sourced from Paris, Milan, and Oxford-South East







Percentage of jobs sourced from London, Paris, Bilbao, and Santander




Jobs in the New York MSA as a percentage of European-sourced jobs



Percentage of jobs sourced from London and Paris




Jobs in the New York MSA as a percentage of European-sourced jobs



Percentage of jobs sourced from Paris, London, Oxford-South East, and Stockholm




Jobs in the Washington MSA as a percentage of European-sourced jobs






Percentage of jobs sourced from London and Paris

Jobs in the Houston MSA as a percentage of European-sourced jobs












Percentage of jobs sourced from Amsterdam and Utrecht



Percentage of jobs sourced from Rotterdam, Munich, Amsterdam, Paris, and Madrid








Percentage of jobs sourced from Aberdeen and London




Percentage of jobs sourced from London, Paris, Birmingham, and Bath






Percentage of jobs sourced from Dublin, London, Paris, Oxford-South East, Jersey-Guernsey, and Brussels


Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in London, Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia, Rotterdam, and Paris

Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in Dublin, Paris, Frankfurt, and Eindhoven







Percentage of jobs sourced from Stuttgart, Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia, Paris, London, and Munich







Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in London and Paris




Enterprises in the Houston MSA as a percentage of all European-owned enterprises



Percentage of jobs sourced from Paris and Luxembourg






Percentage of jobs sourced from Milan and Paris



Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in London, Paris, Santander, and Bilbao






Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in Paris, Stuttgart, Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia, Munich, and London

Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in Paris, Luxembourg, and Birmingham








Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in London and Brussels




Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in Paris and London











Enterprises in the New York, Los Angeles, and Houston MSAs as a percentage of all European-owned enterprises








Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in London






Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia and Munich


Percentage of enterprises owned by entities in Paris, Dublin, Rotterdam, Munich, and London










European Grocery Store Chains' Presence in the United States

Anderlecht (Brussels)-based *Delhaize Group* operated 1,650 grocery stores in the United States in 2011 through its subsidiaries *Food Lion* (1,188 stores), *Hannaford* (179), *Sweetbay* (105), *Harvey's Supermarket* (72), *Bottom Dollar Food* (57), and *Bloom* (49). 511 of the company's stores were located in North Carolina, 330 in Virginia, 144 in South Carolina, 138 in Florida, 120 in Georgia, 80 in Maryland, 56 in Maine, 47 in New York, and 26 in Massachusetts.⁹



Zaandam (Amsterdam)-based *Ahold* operated 217 *Stop & Shop* stores in Southern New England, 183 *Stop & Shop* stores in the New York metropolitan area, 173 *Giant Landover* stores in the Mid-Atlantic region (three states and the District of Columbia, and 181 *Giant Carlisle* stores in the Mid-Atlantic region in 2011.¹⁰


Welwyn Garden City (Cambridge-East)-based *Tesco* operated a large number of grocery stores in the United States in 2011, primarily in Southern California as well as the Phoenix and Las Vegas metropolitan areas through its 100% subsidiary *Fresh & Easy Neighborhood Market*. *Tesco* transferred ownership of *Fresh & Easy* which operated more than 150 stores and employed more than 4,000 people at the time, to *Yucaipa Companies* in late 2013 which subsequently closed the chain's locations in 2015.¹¹

Furthermore, distinct transatlantic connection patterns can be identified: Stockholm-sourced jobs represent 95.82% of all European-sourced jobs in the **Los Angeles** area; jobs in the Los Angeles area 29.25% of all **Stockholm**-sourced investigation and security services jobs; and Stockholm-sourced jobs in the Los Angeles area 19.37% of all European-sourced jobs in the U.S. in this industry.

European Investigation and Security Services Companies in the United States

Stockholm-based *Securitas AB* is one of the world's biggest security services providers. The company held an 18% market share in the United States in 2011. Furthermore, *Securitas AB* employed 34% (108,500) of its total number of employees in 97 geographical areas in North America and realized 35% of sales as well as 38% of operating income through its *Security Services North America* division.¹² The company is a major player in the entertainment security sector in Southern California; for example, *Securitas* has been providing security services to NBC/Universal Studios for many years, employing 500 security officers for this client alone.¹³

G4S, with 657,200 worldwide employees one of the biggest investigation and security services companies in the world, is based in Crawley, England (Oxford-South East) and 59,700 or 9.08% of the company's employees are located in North America.¹⁴





European-sourced motor vehicle part manufacturing industry jobs appear to be concentrated in the following nine destination areas which account for 52,554 jobs or 50.96% of all European-sourced jobs in this industry:



Transatlantic connections in the motor vehicle parts manufacturing industry are characterized by specific patterns: Turin and Stuttgart-sourced jobs represent 70.08% of European-sourced jobs in the **Detroit** area; Turin-sourced jobs 90.24% of jobs in the **Kokomo** area; Paris-sourced jobs 92.8% of jobs in the **Columbus** area; Turin and Stuttgart-sourced jobs together 100% of jobs in the **Toledo** area; Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia-sourced jobs 100% of jobs in the **Marinette** area; Göteborg-sourced jobs 100% of jobs in the **Hagerstown** area; Stuttgart-sourced jobs 100% of jobs in the **Huntsville** area and 61.62% of jobs in the **Charleston** area; and Munich-sourced job 100% of jobs in the **Wooster, OH** area.

Conversely, jobs in the Detroit, Kokomo, and Toledo areas represent 91.87% of all **Turin**-sourced jobs in this industry and jobs in Hagerstown 96.63% of **Göteborg**-sourced jobs.

Paris-based *Faurecia*, the world's sixth largest automotive parts supplier, owns facilities in multiple locations in the United States, including Columbus, IN and Toledo.¹⁷

Munich-based *Schaeffler Group* produces motor vehicle parts in Wooster, OH and operates facilities, amongst others, in Troy, MI (Detroit).¹⁸







A number of specific transatlantic connection patterns can be identified with respect to both industries: Oxford-South East, Paris, and Milan-owned restaurant industry jobs together account for 86.54% of all European-sourced jobs in this industry in the **New York** area; Milan-sourced jobs for 61.62% of all jobs in the **Chicago** area and 41.54% of jobs in the **Washington** area; Oxford-South East, Paris, and Milan-owned restaurant industry enterprises together for 93.48% of all European-owned enterprises in this industry in the **New York** area, 71.79% in the **Washington** area, 96.43% in the **Chicago** area; and 100.00% in the **Boston** area; Oxford-South East-sourced food services industry jobs for 100.00% of European-sourced jobs in this industry in the **Lafayette, LA** area; Milan-sourced jobs for 78.06% of jobs in the **Chicago** area; and Paris-sourced jobs in this industry for 100.00% of jobs in the **Albany** area and 100.00% of jobs in the **Bellingham, WA** area.

A number of particularly important transatlantic connections in the food services industry can be identified and will be explained below: **Oxford-South East-Lafayette, LA; Milan-Chicago; Paris-Albany; Paris-Bellingham, WA; and Oxford-South East-Charlotte.**

European Restaurant and Special Food Services Industries Companies' Presence in the U.S.

Sodexo, formerly *Sodexo Alliance*, headquartered in Issy-les-Moulineaux (Paris), is a multinational restaurant, food services, and facilities management company that is currently serving more than 15 million customers at more than 9,000 client sites and employing more than 132,000 people in the United States.²¹ *Sodexo* operated campus dining services at Western Washington University in Bellingham, WA until late 2011 and still operates such services at University at Albany, SUNY.²²

One of *Sodexo's* main competitors in the restaurant as well as special food services industry is *Compass Group North America*, Charlotte-based subsidiary of *Compass Group*, headquartered in Chertsey (Oxford-South East). *Compass Group North America* has more than 220,000 associates in 50 states, ten provinces, and two territories and serves eight million meals a day - from vending

solutions to restaurants, company cafeterias, schools, arenas, and museums.²³ *ESS Support Services Worldwide* is the specialty division of Compass Group providing premier catering and support services to offshore and remote sites, headquartered in Lafayette, LA.²⁴

Another major player in the North American restaurant industry is Rozzano (Milan)-based *Autogrill*. The group made its entry into the U.S. market in 1999 with the purchase of *Host Marriott Services*, later renamed *HMSHost*.²⁵ *HMSHost* operates a significant number of restaurants and eating places at highway rest areas and airports.²⁶

Wroclaw-based restaurant operator *AmRest* entered the U.S. market in 2008 when the group acquired 80% of *Apple Grove Holding*, the second largest *Applebee's* franchisee in the United States.²⁷ In 2011, the group operated 103 restaurants in the U.S.²⁸


Groupe Le Duff, headquartered in Rennes, is represented in the U.S. market through its brands *La Madeleine Country French Café* and *Bruegger's*, acquired in 2001 and 2011 respectively.²⁹

LSG Sky Chefs, subsidiary of Cologne-based *Lufthansa*, is the world's largest provider of airline catering and in-flight services, operating in a large number of locations in the United States.³⁰

Milan-based *Ali Group*, whose North American operations center is located in Chicago – through its subsidiaries – designs, manufactures, markets, and services commercial and institutional food service equipment used by major restaurant and hotel chains as well as other food services providers.³¹





European Banks' Presence in the United States

A number of large European banks is represented in the United States: London-based *HSBC*'s subsidiary *HSBC Bank USA* employed more than 30,000 people in 2011 and managed more than 97,000 customer accounts.³²

Paris-based *BNP Paribas* is represented in the U.S. market through its subsidiaries *Bank of the West* and *First Hawaiian Bank*, both parts of *BancWest*. Through these companies, *BNP Paribas* employed over 11,500 people in 2011 and operated more than 800 branches.³³

Paris-based *Société Générale* operates offices in New York, Chicago, and Baltimore and is represented in the U.S. market through its subsidiaries *CGI Finance*, *Société Générale Corporate & Investment Banking*, as well as *Société Générale Equipment Finance*.³⁴


Two additional major European banks operate offices in the United States: *Lloyds Banking Group* in New York, Chicago, and Houston and *Crédit Agricole* in New York, Chicago, Houston, and Miami.³⁵

BBVA Compass, subsidiary of Bilbao-based *Banco Bilbao Vizcaya Argentive, S.A. (BBVA)*, was the 25th largest commercial bank in the United States in 2011 based on deposit market share. The company operated 710 branches through Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, New Mexico, and Texas and employed 11,828 people in 2011.³⁶




European Traveler Accommodation Industry Companies' Presence in the United States

AccorHotels, formerly *Accor S.A.*, headquartered in Paris, was the biggest hotel operator in the European Union in 2011.³⁸ The group owned *Motel 6/Studio 6* from 1990 until 2012 when the subsidiary was sold to an affiliate of *Blackstone Real Estate*.³⁹ *Accor S.A.* operated 1,028 establishments under the *Motel 6* brand – 307 owned, 260 leased, and 461 franchised – with a total of 99,438 rooms in North America.⁴⁰

The European Union's third biggest hotel operator in 2011⁴¹, Denham (London)-based *InterContinental Hotels Group*, owned 3,473 establishments in the Americas, mostly under the *Holiday Inn* (816) and *Holiday Inn Express* (1,874) brands.⁴²

Computer Systems Design and Related Services










Munich-based *BMW* operates its North American assembly facility in Spartanburg.⁴⁵

Stuttgart-based *Mercedes Benz* operates a factory in Tuscaloosa as well as, through *Daimler Trucks North America*, facilities in Salisbury (Cleveland Truck Manufacturing Plant), Portland (Portland Truck Manufacturing Plant), Greensboro (Thomas Built Buses Manufacturing Plant), Gaffney (Freightliner Custom Chassis Manufacturing Plant), Charlotte (Mt. 











Together, these eight pairs represent 20,652 jobs or 39.52% of all European-sourced jobs in this industry.

Additionally, London-sourced jobs represent 89.90% of jobs in the **Philadelphia** area; Paris-sourced jobs 83.32% of jobs in the **Boston** area and 100.000% in the **East Stroudsburg** area; Eindhoven-sourced jobs 91.81% in the **Greensboro** area; Koblenz-Ludwigshafen-Palatinate-sourced jobs 100.00% of jobs in the **Bridgeport** area; and Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia-sourced jobs 87.64% of jobs in the **Kansas City** area. Conversely, jobs in the Philadelphia area represent 62.08% of **London**-sourced jobs; jobs in the Boston, East Stroudsburg, and New York areas together 73.75% of **Paris**-sourced jobs; and jobs in the Bridgeport area 49.09% of **Koblenz-Ludwigshafen-Palatinate**-sourced jobs.

European Pharmaceutical and Medicine Manufacturing Companies' Presence in the U.S.

Gentilly (Paris)-based pharmaceutical company *Sanofi* operates a number of locations in the United States, including Ridgefield, NJ (New York); Chattanooga; Allston, Framingham, and Cambridge (Boston); and, through its vaccines division *Sanofi Pasteur*, Swiftwater, PA (East Stroudsburg).⁵³

Ingelheim (Koblenz-Ludwigshafen-Palatinate)-based *Boehringer Ingelheim Pharmaceuticals* operates four locations in the United States, including in Ridgefield, CT (Bridgeport).⁵⁵

One of the two U.S. headquarters of Brentford (London)-based *GlaxoSmithKlein* is located in Philadelphia.⁵⁶

Nijmegen (Eindhoven)-based *Synthon* operates a major location in Durham.⁵⁷





Transatlantic connections in the basic chemical manufacturing industry are dominated by very specific metropolitan region/area pairs, amongst others: **Rotterdam-Houston**; **Amsterdam-Chicago**; **Munich-New York**; and **Koblenz-Ludwigshafen-Palatinate-New York**. Together, the four pairs represent 14,775 jobs or 28.33% of all European-sourced jobs in this industry.

Furthermore, Rotterdam-sourced jobs represent 73.71% of jobs in the **Houston** area; Amsterdam-sourced jobs 67.08% of jobs in the **Chicago** area; Munich and Koblenz-Ludwigshafen-Palatinate-sourced jobs together 66.34% of jobs in the **New York** area; and Koblenz-Ludwigshafen-Palatinate-sourced 54.03% in the **Baton Rouge** area and 94.95% in the **Charlotte** area. Conversely, jobs in Houston represent 79.06% of jobs sourced from the **Rotterdam** area; jobs in Chicago 63.73% of jobs sourced from the **Amsterdam** area; and jobs in New York 38.64% of jobs sourced from the **Munich** area.

European Chemical Manufacturing Companies' Presence in the U.S.

Lyondell Basell (legal domicile in Rotterdam) has its operational headquarters in London and Houston. The company furthermore operates in multiple locations in the Houston metropolitan area, including in Alvin (Chocolate Bayou Polymers Plant), Channelview (Channelview Complex, Houston Technology Center), Houston (Houston Refinery), Mont Belvieu (Mont Belvieu Terminal), and Pasadena (Pipeline Operations, Bayport Underwood Plant, Bayport Polymers Plant, Bayport Choate Plant).⁵⁹

Amsterdam-based *AkzoNobel* has its U.S. headquarter in Chicago.⁶⁰

The U.S. headquarter for Munich-based *Linde Group* is located in Murray Hill, NJ (New York).⁶¹ Ludwigshafen-based *BASF* is headquartered in Florham Park, NJ (New York). The company furthermore operates in Geismar (Baton Rouge), Charlotte, and Seneca, SC.⁶²

Essen (Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia)-based *Evonik Industries* operates in multiple locations in the United States, including Mobile, AL.⁶³

With *Lanxess*, formerly the chemicals division of *Bayer*, another major player in the global chemical industry is headquartered in the Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia region (Cologne).





Diemen (Amsterdam)-based *Randstad Holding* is the second largest human resources services provider in the world behind Swiss *Adecco*.⁶⁴ The company operated 137 in-house locations and 952 staffing/professionals branches in North America in 2011⁶⁵, generating 12% of staffing branches revenue, 32.3% of professionals branches revenue, and 9.6% of in-house services revenue in North America.⁶⁶



Together, these two destination areas account for 11,000 jobs or 26.16% of all European-sourced jobs in this industry.

Furthermore, a number of specific metropolitan region/area pairs are of significance for this industry: **Rotterdam-Cedar Rapids** (6,221 jobs; 14.79% of European-sourced jobs); **Madrid-Worcester, MA** (3,089; 7.35%); **Munich-New York** (2,721; 6.47%); **Munich-San Francisco** (2,145; 5.10%); and **Rotterdam-Baltimore** (2,072; 4.93%). These five pairs together represent 16,248 jobs or 38.64% of all jobs in this industry. In addition, Rotterdam-sourced jobs represent 100% of jobs in the **Cedar Rapids** area; Madrid-sourced jobs 99.84% of jobs in the **Worcester** area; and Munich-sourced jobs 43.74% of jobs in the **New York** area.

Conversely, jobs in Cedar Rapids and Baltimore together account for 58.24% of **Rotterdam**-sourced jobs; jobs in New York and San Francisco for 41.14% of **Munich**-sourced jobs; and jobs in Worcester for 93.24% of **Madrid**-sourced jobs in this industry.

European Insurance Carriers’ Presence in the United States

The Hague (Rotterdam)-based *Aegon* acquired U.S. insurer *Transamerica* in 1999, the head offices of which are located in Baltimore and Cedar Rapids.⁶⁷

The Commerce Insurance Company was bought by Spanish insurer *MAPFRE*, headquartered in Madrid, in 2008. The company, now part of *MAPFRE U.S.A. Group* – the largest private passenger automobile insurer, homeowners’ insurer, and commercial automobile insurer in Massachusetts – is located in Webster, MA (Worcester). *MAPFRE* also owns *Citation Insurance Company* which is headquartered in the same location.⁶⁸

Munich-based *Allianz Global Corporate & Specialty (AGCS)* operates a number of locations in the United States, including in New York and San Francisco.⁶⁹

London-based *Munich RE Group* is also represented in a number of major metropolitan areas in the U.S.⁷⁰

Two additional metropolitan regions mentioned above are home to major European insurance carriers which a significant presence in the U.S. market: Amsterdam (*ING Group*) and Paris (*AXA*).






European School and Employee Bus Transportation Industry Companies

Aberdeen-based *First Group* acquired American school bus operator *Laidlaw* in 2007 for \$3.7 billion.⁷¹ The company, now named *First Student*, the largest private sector of school buses in North America, transported 6 million students per day with a fleet of ~57,000 vehicles in 2011 thereby controlling 11% of the total market and 31% of the outsourced school bus transportation market through more than 1,500 contracts in approximately 600 locations.⁷² *First Student* was responsible for 25% of *First Group*'s revenue and 50% of the company's employees (total: 125,000) in 2011.⁷³ The second major European player in the U.S. student transportation market is *National Express Group* which controlled 10% of the outsourced school bus market in 2011 through its subsidiaries *Durham School Services* and, since September 2011, *Petermann Partners Inc.* The group is headquartered in Birmingham which is inconsistent with the significant percentage of European-sourced school and employee bus transportation jobs sourced from the London region.⁷⁴

Aerospace Product and Parts Manufacturing

European-sourced aerospace industry jobs appear to be concentrated in the following four source regions which account for 36,160 jobs or 86.60% of all European-sourced jobs in this industry:





Two destination areas appear to play an important role for transatlantic aerospace industry connections, accounting for 13,021 jobs or 31.18% of all European-sourced jobs in this industry:



Transatlantic connections in the aerospace industry are characterized by specific patterns: London-sourced jobs represent 100% of jobs in the **Indianapolis** area; Paris-sourced jobs 73.12% of jobs in the **Los Angeles** area and 100.00% of jobs in the **Gainesville, TX** area; London-sourced jobs 78.18% of jobs in the **Washington** area and 100.00% the **Fort Wayne, IN** area; Birmingham-West Midlands-sourced jobs 100.00% of jobs in the **St. Louis** area, 64.01% in the **San Diego** area, and 100.00% in the **Montgomery, AL** area; and Bath-Bristol-Southwest-sourced jobs 100.00% of jobs in the **Akron** area, 100.00% in the **Cedartown, GA** area, and 100.00% in the **Oxnard, CA** area.

Conversely, aerospace industry jobs in St. Louis, San Diego, and Montgomery, AL together represent 75.86% of all **Birmingham-West Midlands**-sourced jobs and jobs in Akron, Cedartown, GA, and Oxnard, CA together 62.01% of all **Bath-Bristol-Southwest**-sourced jobs in this industry.

Three metropolitan region/area pairs also account for 13,716 jobs or 32.85% of all transatlantic aerospace industry connections: **London-Indianapolis**, **Paris-Los Angeles**, and **Birmingham-West Midlands-St. Louis**.

European Aerospace Industry Companies' Presence in the United States

Rolls Royce Helicopters, one of the divisions of London-based *Rolls Royce Holdings*, is located in Indianapolis, the largest operation outside of the United Kingdom, and employs more than 4,000 people. The parent company's North American regional headquarter is located in Reston, VA (Washington).⁷⁵

Two major Paris-based aerospace industry companies, *Thales Group* and *Dassault Systèmes*, have major facilities in the Los Angeles area. Plaisir (Paris)-based *Zodiac Aerospace* furthermore operates a plant in Gainesville.⁷⁶

London-based *BAE Systems* is headquartered in Arlington, VA (Washington) and operates a major facility in Fort Wayne.⁷⁷

British aerospace industry company *GKN Aerospace*, headquartered in Redditch (Birmingham-West Midlands), operates facilities in St. Louis, San Diego, and Montgomery, AL.⁷⁸

Bournemouth (Bath-Bristol-Southwest)-based *Meggitt* is located, amongst others, in Akron, Rockmart, GA (Cedartown), and Simi Valley (Oxnard).⁷⁹

























Two of the world's biggest oil companies are headquartered or incorporated in London: *BP*, formerly *British Petroleum*, and *Royal Dutch Shell*.⁸⁷ *Shell Oil Company*, *Royal Dutch Shell's* North American subsidiary is headquartered in Houston; in addition, the company operates facilities in various locations: Norco Manufacturing Complex and Motiva Refining in the New Orleans area, a Motiva plant in Port Arthur (Beaumont), and the Deer Park Manufacturing Site in the Houston area.⁸⁸ BP's U.S. headquarters are located in Texas and Houston is home to the company's largest number of employees anywhere in the world (9,537 in 2015).⁸⁹

Total S.A., a French multinational oil and natural gas company, is headquartered in Courbevoie (Paris). *Total's* U.S. headquarter is located in Houston and the company operates facilities in a










A number of particularly significant metropolitan region/area pairs with regard to jobs can be identified: **Frankfurt-Los Angeles; Eindhoven-Boston; Frankfurt -Allentown; Dublin-St. Louis; Malmö-Denver; Paris-Dallas; Oxford-South East-New York; and Dublin-Bridgeport.** The eight pairs together account for 14,111 jobs or 36.42% of all European-sourced jobs in this industry. With regard to European-owned enterprises, the industry appears to be relatively decentralized; the ten metropolitan region/area pairs responsible for the highest number of enterprises only represent 10.34% of all European-owned enterprises.



European Health and Personal Care Store Chains' Presence in the United States

Milan-based conglomerate *Luxottica* operated over 7,000 stores in the U.S. alone through its retail subsidiaries *Lenscrafters*, *Sears Optical*, *Sunglasshut*, *Target Optical*, and others in 2012. *Luxottica* also designed and retailed more than 80% of major eyewear brands worldwide.⁹¹

Outpatient Care Centers

European-owned outpatient care centers appear to be concentrated in one source region:

Destination regions with particularly high numbers of Frankfurt-owned outpatient care centers are: **Chicago** (94 enterprises); **Boston** (90); and **Dallas** (54). The industry is relatively centralized in the United States; the top-ten destination areas only account for 25.53% and the top-twenty areas for 37.18% of all Frankfurt-owned outpatient care centers.

European Outpatient Care Center Operators in the United States

Fresenius Medical Care is one of the four divisions of Bad Homburg (Frankfurt)-based *Fresenius* group. The company held a share of 11% of the world's dialysis treatment market in 2011.⁹² *Fresenius Medical Care* owned 1,838 (of 2,898 total) clinics, employed 45,577 (of 79,159 total) people, and treated 61% of total patients in North America (142,319 of 233,156).⁹³ *Fresenius'*



strong footprint in North America and particularly the United States helps to understand the high percentage of Frankfurt-owned outpatient care centers compared to all European-owned enterprises in this industry in the United States.⁹⁴

Hardware; and Plumbing; and Heating Equipment and Supplies Merchant Wholesalers

European-owned enterprises appear to be centralized in the following two source regions which account for 1,052 enterprises or 84.77% of all European-owned enterprises in this industry:




No dominant destination areas can be identified; **California** is responsible for 13.38% (166) of all European-owned enterprises.

Jiffy Lube is a 100% subsidiary of *Shell Oil Company* which itself is a subsidiary of *Royal Dutch Shell*, headquartered in Amsterdam but incorporated and registered in London. Through *Jiffy Lube*, *Shell* operates over 2,000 franchised locations in the United States.⁹⁵

Brussels-based vehicle distribution and automotive repair company *D'Ieteren* owns 94.85% of *Belron*, the worldwide leader in vehicle glass repair and replacement, which operated 2,027 branches and 9,200 mobile units through ten major brands, including *Carglass*, *Autoglass*, and *Safelite AutoGlass*.⁹⁶










Despite the concentration of European-owned enterprises in this industry in a specific source region, no major players could be identified. In particular, no large German retailer was active in the electronics and appliance store sector in the United States in 2011.⁹⁷ It was considered if *T-Mobile* locations were counted not only in the wireless telecommunications carriers sector but also in this industry. Major discrepancies between the number of enterprises for various reasons were identified although. In particular, the number of electronics and appliance stores is higher, amongst others, in the Chicago, Miami, Dallas, and Washington areas.

Clothing Stores

European-owned clothing stores appear to be concentrated in one source region:



Two particularly important destination areas can be identified:



The two destination areas together account for 215 enterprises or 26.32% of all European-owned clothing stores in the United States.

A majority of clothing stores in the biggest metropolitan areas in the U.S. are owned by entities, located in the Paris region, amongst others: **New York** (62.76%); **Los Angeles** (52.86%); **Chicago** (59.09%); **Miami** (56.41%); **Houston** (82.61%); and **Philadelphia** (60.00%). The six aforementioned metro areas account for 25.70% of **Paris**-based enterprises in this industry.

European Clothing Store Chains⁹ in the United States

The European-owned clothing store industry in the U.S. is relatively fragmented. Nevertheless, major Paris-based companies are represented through a number of brands in the United States: *LVMH Moët Hennessy Luis Vuitton SE* owns, amongst others, the following brands: *Céline*, *Christian Dior*, *Emilio Pucci*, *Givenchy*, *Kenzo*, *Louis Vuitton*, *Marc Jacobs*, and *Thomas Pink*.⁹⁸



Kering, formerly *PPR*, owns, amongst others, the following brands: *Alexander McQueen*, *Brioni*, *Gucci*, and *St. Laurent*.⁹⁹

Also represented in the U.S. clothing stores sector is Paris-based *Hermès*.



European Gasoline Station Operations' Presence in the United States

Two major oil companies, headquartered or incorporated in London, dominate the European-owned gasoline station sector in the United States: *Royal Dutch Shell*, through its subsidiary *Shell Oil Company*, and *BP*. More than 15,000 gasoline stations are currently being operated in the U.S. under the *Shell* brand and more than 7,000 *BP* or *ARCO* branded gasoline stations were operated in the U.S. at the end of 2014.¹⁰⁰ The discrepancy between the number of enterprises operated under the respective brands and the total number of European-owned gasoline stations (813) can most likely be explained by the fact that the majority of establishments are operated by franchisees.

Wireless Telecommunications Carriers (Except Satellite)

European-owned wireless telecommunication industry enterprises appear to be concentrated in one source region:





European Wireless Telecommunications Carriers' Presence in the United States

Bonn (Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia)-based *Deutsche Telekom* is represented in the U.S. mobile telecommunications market through its subsidiary *T-Mobile*, headquartered in Bellevue, WA (Seattle).¹⁰¹

Cement and Concrete Product Manufacturing

European-owned cement and concrete product manufacturing industry enterprises appear to be concentrated in the following three source regions which account for 563 enterprises or 84.16% of all European-owned enterprises in this industry:



No dominant destination regions and no distinct transatlantic connection patterns can be identified.

European Cement and Concrete Product Manufacturing Companies in the United States

Three of the four biggest European companies in this industry are headquartered in the source regions mentioned above: *Heidelberg Cement* (Stuttgart-Mannheim-Baden Württemberg), *Lafarge* (Paris), and *CRH* (Dublin).¹⁰² *Lafarge* operates facilities in more than 900 locations in the United States, *CRH* in more than 400.¹⁰³

Nondepository Credit Intermediation

The nondepository credit intermediation industry is defined by the U.S. Census Bureau as comprising “establishments, both public (government-sponsored enterprises) and private, primarily engaged in extending credit or lending funds raised by credit market borrowing, such as issuing commercial



paper or other debt instruments or by borrowing from other financial intermediaries.” The industry includes, amongst others, credit card issuing, sales financing, and consumer lending.¹⁰⁴





No dominant destination areas or distinct transatlantic connection patterns can be identified. The five U.S. metro areas with the most European-owned enterprises in this industry only account for 11.62%, the ten areas with the most enterprises in the industry only for 18.49% of all European-owned shoe stores.

European Shoe Store Chains' in the United States

Essen (Düsseldorf-Cologne-Westphalia)-based *Deichmann Group* purchased *Rack Room Shoes*, established in 1920 in Salisbury, NC and headquartered in Charlotte since 1995, in 1984. Since the acquisition, *Rack Room Shoes* has grown significantly and operated more than 450 stores in 34 states under the names *Rack Room Shoes* and *Off Broadway Shoe Warehouse* in 2013.¹⁰⁵

Herzogenaurach (Munich)-based *Adidas* realized 23% of the company's sales in North America in 2011, totaling \$3.10 billion. *Adidas* operates stores in a large number of metropolitan areas in the United States.¹⁰⁶

Agencies; Brokerages; and Other Insurance Related Activities

European-owned enterprises in this industry appear to be concentrated in the following five source regions which account for 546 enterprises or 89.80% of all European-owned enterprises in this industry:



No dominant destination area and no distinct transatlantic connection patterns can be identified.


The industry also appears to be too fragmented to allow for an analysis of major players. A comparison with jobs in the insurance carrier industry shows although that major European insurance companies, active in the United States, are headquartered in Paris, Rotterdam, and Munich. It is not unreasonable to consider that these companies' brokers in the U.S. contribute to the numbers presented above.
