As you can now see the new front entrance structure is really taking shape and the weather is helping so the rate of progress is on schedule.

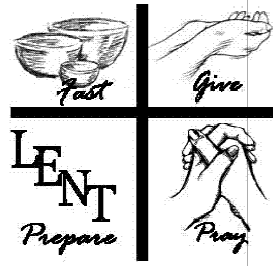
Dermot Nally (Finance Chair)

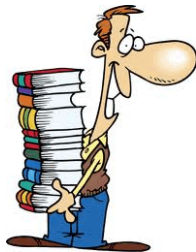
The Social Chair position on Pastoral Council is open!
