SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

**NDSCC Grass Roots Rally,
Saturday 29th August 2015**

1: AUTHORITY:

The event is authorised by CAMS permit No. 415/2908/03 and shall be conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FIA and the NCRs of CAMS, the National Rally Code, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and instructions as may be issued, subject to NCR 69 of the current CAMS Manual. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

2: EVENT DESCRIPTION, FORMAT & COURSE:

The event shall be Special Stage multi club status rally, known as the "NDSCC Grass Roots Rally" conducted on private property at "Lawn Creek", 496 Hirstglen Rd, Hirstglen QLD 4395 on an unsealed surface.

There will be approx six (6) special stages. The stages will be run in a clock wise direction and the same stage in an anti clock wise direction. Depending on time available, more stages using the same course may be added at the discretion of the event organisers on the day.

Total competitive distance will be approx 50km with no liaison.

No route instructions will be issued for this event and competitors are required to write their own route/pace notes. Time prior to the event has been allowed to conduct reconnaissance of each stage twice only in each direction.

5: INSURANCE:

1. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.
2. Third Party Insurance: All competing vehicles carrying civil registration in Queensland require a Third Party extension certificate or letter (CTP) stating the full title of the event, location and date. Any unregistered vehicles must complete and sign a Non Registered vehicle statement.

6: ABANDONMENT:

In accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual, the organisers reserve the right to abandon, cancel, postpone, terminate or alter the event at anytime.



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7: ENTRIES, FEES & SCHEDULE:

Entries open with the issuing of these regulations and close on Friday the 21st August 2015.

The entry fee is \$150.00. For drivers under the age of 25, entry fee will be \$125.00

Fully completed Entry Forms must be sent to the Event Secretary prior to the close of entries. Payment will be cash or cheque only, on the day of the event. Cheques are to be payable to 'Northern Districts Sporting Car Club'.

Number of entries may be limited to 30 and shall be accepted in order of receipt of fully completed entry form, and or, at the discretion of the Clerk of Course and Secretary. A priority system may be used, whereby Youn'guns and Novice drivers will take precedence. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry, in accordance with the provisions of NCR83 of the current CAMS Manual. Any one car may be multi entered with up to a maximum of 2 entries. Change of entries details will be permitted up to the close of documentation.

8: VEHICLE SCRUTINY & COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY:

Scrutiny shall be conducted on site, on the 29th August commencing from 7.30am.

Vehicles All Rally/Road vehicles meeting Schedule R of the CAMS manual and carrying a current CAMS log book for their relevant class/group will be eligible to compete. These include but not limited to Club, PRC, Historic, Classic, G2, SUV, Group N (P) and all FIA groups.

A vehicle may be entered up to a maximum of two drivers.

Drivers must hold a current and valid CAMS Clubman Rally (CR) or higher licence. As the event is entirely on private property, a civil licence is not required. Each driver will only be permitted to enter once. At the discretion of the event Clerk of Course and Secretary, a driver may change vehicles during the event. Minimum age for drivers holding a National Rally Junior (NRJ) licence is 14.

Co-Drivers must hold a current and valid CAMS Clubman Rally or higher licence. A Rally Navigator Single Event licence (RSNSE) will be accepted. This CANNOT be obtained on the day and must be applied for well before the event. Contact event secretary or CoC for further information if required. A Co-driver may be nominated in up to two (2) competition vehicles. Minimum age for navigators holding a National Rally Junior (NRNJ) licence is 14.

Apparel, including helmets and all clothing shall comply with Schedule D, (2.2 Road/Rally-Multi-Club-Gravel) of the current CAMS Manual.

Documents: Competitors must present at scrutiny;

- CAMS Competition Licence
- Current CAMS-Affiliated Club Membership (can be purchased on the day)
- Vehicle Log Book
- CTP extension for vehicle registered in QLD. (Non registered vehicles will be required to complete a Non registered vehicle statement on the day).

9: DRIVERS BRIEFING:

A compulsory briefing for all drivers, co-drivers and service crew will be held on site on Sunday 29th Aug at 9.35am prior to reconnaissance and again at 10.50am prior to competition.

10:TIMING:

Timing will use A-B as per the National Rally Code.

HANDICAP: 4WD/Turbo charged vehicles will be handicapped (added to their accumulated stage times) at a rate of 2.5 seconds per competitive kilometre.

11:PROTESTS:

Protests or appeals must be made in accordance with Part XII (Protests) and Part XIII (Appeals) of the NCR's of the current CAMS Manual.

12:SERVICING:

Competitors will be permitted to enter the service area between stages without penalty.

13:DRIVER CATAGORIES/CLASSES: (note there are no specific vehicle classes)

Class A: YOUN'GUN
Class B: NOVICE
Class C: PRO

A Novice competitor will be determined & decided by the event Clerk of Course.

A Youn'gun will be a competitor born on or prior to 31st Dec 1990.

Drivers not eligible or accepted in Youn'gun or Novice will be automatically be assigned in Pro Class.

14:DETERMINATION OF WINNERS:

The results will be determined by accumulative stage times, (including handicap for 4wd) fastest to the slowest in each class. Award will be presented to:

- 1st 2nd & 3rd Youn'gun
- 1st 2nd, & 3rd Novice
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd Pro
- Bosses Best (as judged by CoC & his nominee's based on a combined effort of preparation, presentation & consistent performance)

15:FIRST AID AND MEDICAL:

An adequately trained first aid (FIV) medical and emergency personal will be on site during the hours of competition and will be station at the central service area.

16:COMPLIANCE WITH INSTRUCTION:

Any competitor failing to follow the direction of any Official will be charged with a breach of the rules and may render a competitor liable to exclusion from the Meeting.

17:ALCOHOL / DRUGS:

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent



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licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

18: MOTOR SPORT IS DANGEROUS

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the event, you agree:

- to release Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (“**CAMS**”) and Australian Motor Sport Commission Ltd, promoters, sponsor organisations, land owners and lessees, organisers of the event, their respective servants, officials, representatives and agents (collectively, the “**Associated Entities**”) from all liability for your death, personal injury (including burns), psychological trauma, loss or damage (including property damage) (“**harm**”) howsoever arising from your participation in or attendance at the event, except to the extent prohibited by law;
- that CAMS and the Associated Entities do not make any warranty, implied or express, that the event services will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied; and
- to attend or participate in the event at your own risk.

You acknowledge that:

- the risks associated with attending or participating in the event include the risk that you may suffer harm as a result of:
 - motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles, persons or property;
 - acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
 - the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure the safety of persons or property at the event.

VENUE DIRECTIONS – 496 Hirstglen Rd, Hirstglen QLD, approximately 40km from Gatton & Toowoomba. Signs will be erected from Heifer Creek Rd into the venue. Note a 40kph speed limit applies while transiting along Hirstglen Rd.

Catering: Catering and cold drinks will be available on site during the day.

Camping: Available with hot showers & flush toilets.
