

## ~ DAIRY ~

Dairy products are staples of the American diet. To make ensure Americans receive the dairy products needed, dairy farmers work hard to provide these high quality products. Before modern milking machines, a farmer could milk about six cows by hand in one hour. Now farmers can milk over 100 cows in an hour! Illinois has about 102,000 dairy cows that produce close to 2 billion pounds of milk in a year, using automated equipment. Not only is the automated milking process faster, but also is a cleaner and safer method of milking cows. Dairy farmers use a variety of automated methods including: Bucket Milking, Robotic Milking, Stanchion Barn Milking, Parlor Milking, and Rotary Parlor Milking.

Dairy cows come in a variety of colors. In the United States, Holsteins, or black and white cows are most common. Other breeds include Jersey Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Ayrshire and Milking Shorthorn. These breeds come in variety of colors including: tan, brownish gray, golden brown and reddish brown. Sometimes cows will also have these colors in patches. Certain breeds provide a lot of milk while others produce milk richer in fat or protein. Farmers improve the herd's genetics by selecting cows that have a higher content of protein or fat in their milk.

### ROCK'N ROLL ICE CREAM RECIPE

**INGREDIENTS:**


- |                           |                            |

| 1 pint sized Ziploc bag   | Duct tape                  |
| 1 pint of half and half   | Gallon Ziploc bag          |
| ½ cup of sugar            | Ice                        |
| A little vanilla or fruit | 2 tablespoons of rock salt |

**DIRECTIONS:**

1. In an empty clean quart-size Ziploc bag, mix 1 pint of half & half with ½ cup of sugar. Add a little vanilla or sugar if you prefer.
2. Seal the quart-size Ziploc bag, secure it with duct tape and then place it inside of an empty clean gallon-size Ziploc bag.
3. Pack ice around the quart-size Ziploc bag. Then sprinkle about 2 tablespoons of rock salt on the ice. Finally, fill the rest of the gallon-size bag with ice.
4. Seal the gallon size bag and secure it with duct tape.
5. Lay a tarp on the floor. Toss bag back and forth for about 10 minutes.
6. Remove the small bag and rinse it with water before opening. If you do not, you may end up with salt in your ice cream.
7. Enjoy!

- Bull:** Male cattle used for breeding
- Calcium:** A mineral found in dairy products and is needed for healthy teeth and bones
- Calf:** Cattle less than one year old
- Cow:** A female cow that has given birth to a calf
- Dairy:** Food group containing milk and milk products
- Hay:** Grass, clover or alfalfa that is cut, dried and baled, and fed to cattle
- Heifer:** Female cattle that have not had a calf
- Homogenize:** Process of heating and cooling milk to kill bacteria and protect its purity and flavor
- Pasture:** Land covered with grass and other low plants suitable for grazing animals
- Silage:** Fermented corn, wheat or hay with the stalks and leaves that is chopped and fed to cattle
- Silo:** structure for storing bulk materials. Silos are used in agriculture to store grain or fermented feed known as silage
- Udder:** Part of a dairy cow that produces, stores and dispenses milk




