



ANDOVER'S BUILDING MARKER PROGRAM

Andover's Building Marker Program is co-sponsored by the Andover Historical Society and the Andover Historical Commission. The goal of the program is to publicly note significant buildings in town and to provide the public with a graphic image of Andover's development over time. Your participation in this program will serve to document much of the town's growth.

An attractive plaque containing the building's name and its date of construction (circa is fine) is ordered by the Andover Historical Society. The name of the building is often for the original occupant, a long-time owner, the current or locally accepted place-name. The date is associated with its construction, first development, or a significant event.

Plaques cost \$125.00 each.

Plaques are white composite material with dark blue vinyl letters. These composite markers replace wooden markers that had been used for decades. If you have an old wooden marker that is failing and needs to be replaced, please call Andover Historical at 978-475-2236.
