

TEXAS STATE OUTDOOR CONVENTIONAL PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP

May 6-7, 2017

- LOCATION:** The tournament will be held at the outdoor range of the Amarillo Rifle & Pistol Club in Amarillo, TX. If you are going west on I-40 turn right on Western St., if you are going east on I-40 turn left on Western St. go 7 miles north. The range is located on the east side of the road.
- TIME:** Saturday and Sunday, May 6 & 7, 2015, firing will commence at 8:00 A.M. sharp.
- RULES:** Current NRA pistol rules will govern in all matches: Triggers may be checked at any time during the match. A set of NRA approved trigger weights will be available for competitors to check their firearms prior to the match. Triggers will be weighed for the CMP EIC match, CMP .22 Rimfire match and NRA Distinguished Revolver match.
- ELIGIBILITY:** **All competitors must be members of the TSRA. Non-Texas residents may become a Match Member for a fee of \$10.00. A Match Member is a member of TSRA for the duration of the match.**
- ENTRIES LIMITED:** Entries limited to **52** competitors
- POST ENTRIES:** Accepted to range limitation, will close at 7:30 A.M. on May 6, 2017.
- ENRTY FEES:** **Match 1-16 (.22, CF, .45), \$55.00, Match 1-10 (.22, CF), \$ 36.00, Match 1-5 (.22), \$22.00:** Juniors – half price. TSRA Team Support included in registration fee. TEAM ENTRY FEE for .22, CF and .45 team matches is \$16 (\$8.00 each). CMP EIC match \$15, CMP .22 Rimfire EIC match \$15, NRA DR match \$ 1. Fees do not include TSRA membership dues, (required if not a current member). **PRE-REGISTRATION REQUESTED**
NOTE: If a competitor pays a package fee but drops out of competition after having fired any portion of the match no refund will be given (emergencies excepted). Entry fee accepted at the match.

- SQUADDING:** 26 Firing points; 6 Relays total; .22 & CF Saturday and .45 match Sunday.
- CLASSIFICATION:** NRA Classification system will be used for all matches. Assigned classification (Rule 19.6) may be used in making entry. **Classification and TSRA membership cards will be checked at time of registration.** Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class unless there are three (3) or more unclassified competitors. In this case a special class will be provided and awards given.
- AWARDS:** Match Winner and First in class a trophy, except that no competitor will be eligible for more than one trophy in class.
First place will be awarded for 3-6 competitors in a class
Second place will be awarded for 7-11 competitors
Third place will be awarded for over 12 competitors
A trophy will be awarded to the High Grand Senior, High Senior, High Junior, and High Woman.
**IF THERE ARE LESS THAN 3 COMPETITORS IN THE HIGH MASTER CLASS
THEY WILL SHOOT FOR THE WIN ONLY.**
- TEAM MATCH:** The team matches will be a **fired match** and will be fired on Saturday after the last relay. Teams will be two person teams.

TEAM AWARDS: A trophy will be awarded to the team winners providing there is a minimum of three (3) teams in each class.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. See NRA rules for correct procedure.

ACCOMMODATION: All of the major motel/hotel chains are represented on I-40 within a few minutes of the range.

METHOD OF FIRES: There will be 4 relays on Saturday and 2 relays on Sunday, if more than 26 competitors sign up.

Eligibility for EIC match: Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate

Course of Fire: National Match Course of Fire (see rule 7.3.1 Table 5)

Firearm: "Service Pistol" as defined in the current edition of the CMP Rule book (see rule 6.3).

Awards: EIC points towards Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge. All awards and points will be issued by the CMP.

Rules: In accordance with the current edition of the CMP Rulebook. All EIC Service Pistol Matches will be governed by CMP Rules.

Eligibility for the .22 Rimfire EIC match: Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate

Course of Fire: National Match Course of Fire (see rule 7.3.1 Table 5)

Firearm: Any .22 Rimfire pistol or revolver as defined in the current CMP Rule Book (see rule 6.4).

Awards: EIC points towards Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge. All awards and points will be issued by the CMP.

Rules: In accordance with the current edition of the CMP Rulebook. All EIC .22 Rimfire Matches will be governed by CMP Rules.

Eligibility for the NRA Distinguished Revolver match: You must shoot the 2700 to be eligible to shoot the DR match. Current NRA rules apply. See rule 3.1.4 in the current NRA Pistol Rule Book.

There will be a TSRA meeting during the match to nominate a Pistol Director for the coming two year term, if we have sufficient TSRA members to constitute a quorum.

Lunch: The local 4H smallbore shooters will be providing lunch in the indoor range classroom. Price and menu will be announced prior to the match.
