### 2017 Junior Training, Competition, and Tournament Plan

In 2017, we plan to provide our junior players with a wider range of competition options.

We will continue to participate in the Diamond Creek Force Netball Association (DCFNA) and Whittlesea & District Netball Association (WDNA) competitions held on Saturdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, however in addition we will offer a Saturday competition being played at the Banyule & District Netball Association (BDNA) competition highlighted below in orange text.

The BDNA competition teams will be formed by invitation after trials and subsequent selection. The teams entered will form a key part of our tournament team development program. Players that are selected to participate in the BDNA competition will be entered in high level tournaments usually for Association teams. The entry to BDNA will provide the opportunity for the selected teams to play regular competition together between Association tournaments.

## Notes:

1. LPNC has, at its core, club netball in training as a club, playing as a club and going to tournament at club level. However, we also want to challenge those who want to extend their skills by trying out for Association representative teams. As our club continues to grow in size, we are looking to increase our opportunities for Association representative trials and selection.
2. Players selected to play in the BDNA competition on Saturdays and therefore play in Association Tournaments will still be able to try out and be selected for the Diamond Creek Force Representative teams. We will ensure that the tournaments selected do not overlap with the DC Force Tournament schedule.
3. Players selected to play in the BDNA competition on Saturdays must play for at least 12 months before they will be eligible to try out for Banyule & District Netball Association Representative Teams as per the BDNA rules.
4. Players that are selected to play in all of the above outlined competitions and also play for DC Force can expect to play and train up to 4 times a week and potentially play in up to 12 tournaments throughout the year.
