Cities & Ports

Lucerne

Enjoy 2-nights in Lucerne, a traditional Swiss town along the banks of Lake Lucerne with an Alpine backdrop. Enjoy a **Lucerne Walking Tour** of this medieval gem and see some of the city's lovely cobblestone streets, monuments, fountains, public squares, covered bridges, colorful frescoed buildings and the iconic 14th century Chapel Bridge. Also visit the Lion Monument, a dramatic sculpture that honors the Swiss Guards killed during the French Revolution.

Basel

Basel is Switzerland's 3rd most populated city and is located where the Swiss, French & German borders meet. The city has a glorious past still evident in its medieval Town Hall, exquisite 18th-century homes and many museums. Enjoy a panoramic **Basel City Tour** & board your ship in this historic city.

Breisach (Black Forest area)

Breisach, is a beautiful small town situated on the Rhine River that houses one of Europe's largest wine cellars and serves as a gateway to the Black Forest. Venture into the densely wooded Black Forest via motorcoach for your **Black Forest Tour** featuring a Cuckoo Clock Factory visit. This afternoon maybe take the optional excursion to Colmar, France in the nearby Alsace region.

Strasbourg

Capital city of the Alsace region in northeastern France, Strasbourg is situated on the Rhine at the German border. Enjoy a **Strasbourg City Tour** to see Orangerie, the town's oldest park, the European Parliament, and the Place de la Republique. Afterwards, take a walking tour of the lovely "La Petite France" neighborhood and see the Gothic cathedral with its famous astronomical clock.

Speyer & Mannheim

Arrive in Speyer one of Germany's oldest cities, known for its cathedral, numerous churches and the 13th-century Altpörtel ("Old Gate"). Explore the city during your **Speyer Walking Tour**. Cruise to Mannheim & maybe take an optional excursion to historic Heidelberg to visit the red-walled castle and get beautiful views of the Neckar Valley.

Rudesheim - Rhine River Gorge - Koblenz

Enjoy a **Rudesheim Walking Tour** including a visit to Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum and explore the Drosselgasse, a narrow alley lined with wine taverns and restaurants. Midday, your ship departs and cruises through the **Rhine River Gorge**, a UNESCO Heritage Site and the most stunningly beautiful stretch of the river with hillsides dotted with fairy-tale castles, historic towns and vineyards. This afternoon arrive in Koblenz and enjoy a **Koblenz Walking Tour** of this charming Rhineland town situated at the confluence of the Rhine & Moselle Rivers.

Cologne

Cologne is Germany's 4th largest city and located on both sides of the Rhine. Enjoy a **Cologne Walking Tour** of the old part of the city and visit the fabled 13th century Gothic cathedral. Explore the dock side taverns, cafes and shops.

Amsterdam

Amsterdam is known as the "Venice of the North." Enjoy an **Amsterdam City Tour** featuring the historic city center, views of the Royal Palace and an **Amsterdam Canal Cruise** through the intricate canal system passing under some of the city's 500 bridges. Cruise by beautiful homes that line the water and see the fabled Skinny Bridge.

Volendam

Travel through the Dutch countryside with its idyllic landscapes. Make a stop at a famous area of **Windmills** for views and photos of the Holland icon. Visit **Volendam**, an old fishing village offering dutch traditions such as wooden shoes, traditional costumes and cheese making.
