



Curb-to-Curb

Customers receive Curb-to-Curb (Demand-Response) service. Passenger assistance is always available. Unlike a taxi service, Demand-Response service works in time ranges by grouping rides within the same area utilizing one vehicle.

All rides are subject to availability. Curb-to-curb service within all of Eaton County. Advance reservations are required. You can reserve a ride up to two weeks in advance. Ride requests can be made from 6:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Due to increasing service demands, allow ample time to travel.

Downtown Lansing Express

Downtown Lansing Express morning bus leaves Charlotte, Grand Ledge and along Saginaw Hwy in Delta Township arriving in downtown Lansing approximately 7:45 a.m. Returns from downtown Lansing between 5:00-5:15 p.m.

Out of County Medical Trips

Available Monday-Friday. EATTRAN will transport passengers to and from Medical appointments outside of Eaton County into Ingham County areas of Lansing, East Lansing and Okemos. Between the appointment hours of 11:00 a.m. and return no later than 3:30 p.m.

Time Calls

Customers can make advance reservations for appointments up to two (2) weeks in advance. Contact Scheduling for details.



1. EATTRAN may make several stops, so plan a longer trip time than in a car.
2. EATTRAN riders must be prepared to board the bus at the designated pick up time and location. EATTRAN drivers are directed to wait 3 minutes before departing.
3. EATTRAN has a 20 minute window of arrival. All passengers are assigned a pick-up time. The bus may arrive 10 minutes early or 10 minutes late.
4. Passengers must be prepared to board the EATTRAN bus 10 minutes prior to arrival. Drivers will wait only 3 minutes for you to board. Remember, someone else is waiting for the bus too.
5. EATTRAN requires exact fare; drivers do not make change, or credit rides.
6. It may be necessary to make several stops before your destination to accommodate other passengers.
7. EATTRAN will make every effort to serve you during adverse weather conditions. Delays and cancellations are possible. We reserve the right to cancel service due to adverse weather conditions. Check your local TV and radio stations for delays, cancellations and updates.
8. NO weapons, illegal drugs, hazardous materials or dangerously-deemed items will be permitted on the bus.
9. EATTRAN does not allow eating, smoking (Including vapor Cigarettes), drinking, vulgar language on buses.
10. EATTRAN drivers will assist passengers when requested. Please limit the number of packages brought on the bus. You may be charged an extra fare for excessive packages.
11. Drivers do not use driveways
12. If you change plans, please call the EATTRAN office and cancel your ride. (You will be charged for rides not canceled)
13. You may schedule up to 2 weeks in advance
14. EATTRAN is closed on the following holidays: New Years, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas
15. Disability forms are available upon request. Anyone possessing a Medicare card is eligible for certification.
16. Children under 5 must be accompanied by an adult
17. Objectionable odors from any source unavoidable by other passengers will not be permitted.
18. EATTRAN will not tolerate any type of violence, threats, intimidation, destruction of property or insubordination. EATTRAN has the right to refuse service and remove passengers when necessary
19. EATTRAN demands that passengers conduct themselves in an acceptable and respectful manner at all times. Any type of lewd or indecent behavior is unacceptable. Failure to comply will result in immediate removal.
20. EATTRAN has the right to temporarily or permanently ban passengers from service when it is necessary.

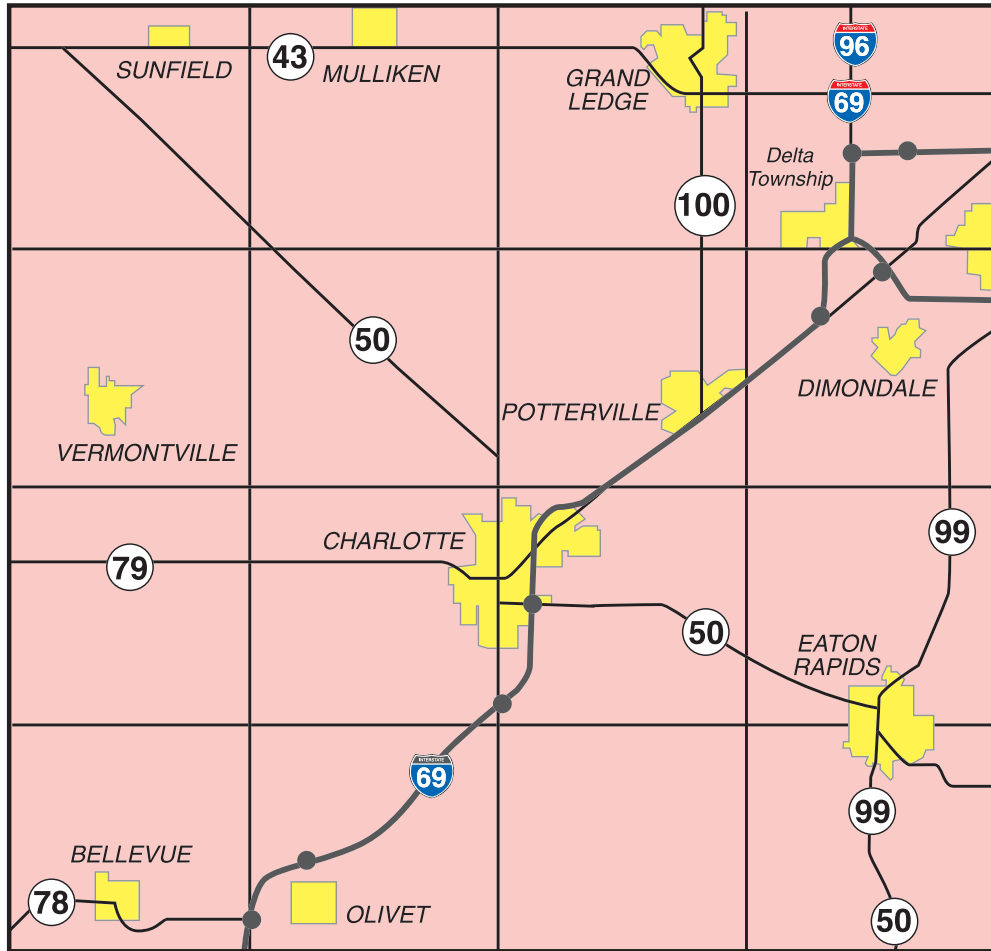

The Eattran Connector is a quick and convenient way to get from the Charlotte Walmart to the Lansing Mall. Plan time for your trip as a one way trip takes approximately 1/2 hour. The Connector makes 3 stops, Charlotte Walmart, Potterville Frank's and the Lansing Mall.

You can simply meet the bus at any of the three stops. Or you can call and set up a curb to curb pick up to transfer you to the connector route or meet another bus at the mall to finish taking you where you need to go in the Delta area.
