Make a Move



That's where consignment stores come into play. Consignment stores are popping up all over Orange County and here are two that are looking for very different items to buy:

Uptown Cheapskate in Lake Forest and Fullerton: If you have a ton of gently used trendy clothes or items from Forever 21, Urban Outfitters or Michael Kors, then take them to Uptown Cheapskate. I love this store because they will take the trendy less expensive items

Filmore & 5th in Dana Point: If your closet represents brands more like Gucci and Prada than Forever 21, then Filmore & 5th is your consignment store. They buy and sell gently used and in good condition high end brands such as Louis Vuitton, Tory Burch and more. They also look for seasonal items and on trend. Along with selling your items you can also find that dream handbag or pair of shoes that were too expensive to buy retail, but now you can finally afford them!

A lot of companies offer an incentive to have you donate items that will later go to local shelters they support. One such company is Spa Gregorie's Day Spas and Salons in Newport Beach and Rancho Santa Margarita. Every March they have a "Detox and Donate Retail Sale" where they offer 10% off any 2 full-priced retail items when you donate 2 gently used toiletries or clothing items or 20% off when you donate 3 or more items. All the items are then donated to the Orange County Rescue Mission.

So if you're thinking of keeping a sweater that you wore on the 7th date with an ex-boyfriend, think again and detox that closet! Remember out with the old and in with the new! That means new dresses, shoes, handbags etc.!
