The Tidewater Winds is a professional concert band performing in the tradition of the Sousa Band. 2015 marks our 30th year of free summer concerts held in Norfolk, Chesapeake, Portsmouth, and Virginia Beach. Under the baton of Maestro John H. Brewington, the Tidewater Winds will be presenting a four week season.

For 30 years, the Tidewater Winds has provided a valuable training platform for Tidewater's college musicians through our College Student Intern Program. This program provides an opportunity for college students to gain professional performance experience during our summer season. Each student intern is paired with a professional musician to mentor them throughout their time with the Winds. Student Interns are encouraged to seek advice/help with the music or any other aspect of playing with the band. Additionally, each college-level intern will receive \$25 for each rehearsal and \$20 for each performance. At the end of the season, the student intern is evaluated on preparedness, musical ability, deportment and progress within the group. These evaluations will then be made available to the student.

We encourage you to consider this opportunity for advanced students. All applicants to the program must meet the require College Student Intern Program:

1. Applicants must be studying music at the collegiate level.
2. Applicants must complete the enclosed Student Intern Registration form their applied teacher's signature.
3. Applicants must have a recommendation from their applied teacher. Please make sure recommendations are submitted with this registration form.
4. All applicants must be available during the month of July. All rehearsals are mandatory. If you are unable to make a scheduled rehearsal, you will not be eligible to play that particular week.
5. All applicants must take the audition scheduled for Sunday, May 22nd at Granby High School. Audition materials are available on the Tidewater Winds official website www.tidewaterwinds.org or by request via e-mail.
6. Each intern is required to provide a short essay recapping their experience as a part of the Tidewater Winds ensemble during the summer season.
