## ON THE WING AGAIN




In observance of Memorial Day, we went with Chapter U to visit the traveling Vietnam Memorial Wall. The weather was good and we continued to lunch down River Road towards



## Tux Penguin's Recipe for FUN\*

#### <u>Ingredients</u>

- 1. 10 to an unlimited number of GWRRA Members or potential Members
- 2. Couples encouraged
- 3. Bikes and trikes with accessories to match
- 4. Fun loving attitudes
- 5. Young at heart attributes
- 6. Spirits of adventure
- 7. Willing to travel/ride
- 8. Tools, nuts, and bolts
- 9. Safety consciousness
- 10. Educationally oriented
- 11. All the gear, all the time (ATGATT)
- 12. Meeting Place



Thoroughly mix the first three ingredients in a central meeting place. Sprinkle with fun loving, young at heart attitudes, and a spirit of adventure willing to ride Honda Gold Wings. Allow to grow and get to know each other for at least one month. During that month look for other like-minded souls who can positively flavor the recipe. Add new folks to recipe. Remix after 30 days and fold in safety consciousness, motorcycle oriented educational opportunities, some tools, nuts and bolts and the wearing of ATGATT, and you will have the strong beginnings of a great GWRRA motorcycle Chapter.

The following thoughts should be kept in mind to understand the peculiarities of your GWRRA motorcycle Chapter.

- At times the recipe can be heated, but it does best when left to sit and age.
- · Mixing and melding of ingredients over time produces best results.
- Whipping the ingredients tends to make the final product tough and hard to work with.
- Kneading the ingredients and allowing them time to grow and rise to the occasion makes for a better final product.
- Level of doneness depends on the situation, ingredients, and interest of the cooks.
- Everyone will not like the results.
- Help is needed at various stages in making the product, but there can be only one primary cook (i.e., too many cooks spoil the broth).
- Everyone does not have to be part of every activity, but try to include everyone in some of your activities.
- Fresh ideas and tweaking the recipe keeps interest level up, and makes for new experiences and tastes.
- You can manipulate the recipe to be more specialized or to be more diverse; learn what your group likes.

#### Years of experience:

I began riding motorcycles around 1974. My first bike was a RD 250 Yamaha, a street bike that became my work commuter between Antioch and Martinez. It was a 20 mile read each way. About 2 years later I upgraded to Honda CB 450, then upgraded again to a full dress CB750. By then I not only commuted to Martinez but also traveled daily to Richmond and Alameda for school.

#### Places traveled:

I took my first long trip around 1980, when I picked up my brother and we went to Happy Camp at the northern border of California and Oregon. About an 800 mile round trip.

Because of my work, I did not always have a chance to ride and my commute was only about 1.5 miles I sold the CB750. I did not begin to ride again until 2003, when I bought 1985 Goldwing to see if I still would enjoy riding. It turned out that I still found it fun and my wife enjoyed being my co-rider. Naturally my goal became to buy a new Goldwing. After going through some tough times in 2010 I saw this black 2008 Goldwing with all the Bells and whistles, including an airbag. I have been from California to Washington, to South Carolina to Texas, to Cincinnati, Ohio to Texas to California, to Washington, Madison Wisconsin to Texas to California to Washington to California and from Texas to California and back.
