Rhubarb

Stalks make delicious pies, sauce & jam.

What Type of Soil: Rhubarb grow in acid, alkaline, sandy, clay or any type of black soil. If potting, use any type of potting soil.

How to Plant: Dig a hole as deep as the division. Place division in the hole with buds facing up. Buds should be 1" below ground level. If fall planted, put a mound of soil about 6-8" on top of division. This will keep the plant from heaving out in the spring. Plant 2' apart.

When to Plant: Rhubarb is a cool weather growing plant, plant as early in spring as possible.

Where to Plant: On edge of vegetable garden, in foundation plantings, border plantings.

Will only grow 24" tall the second year.
