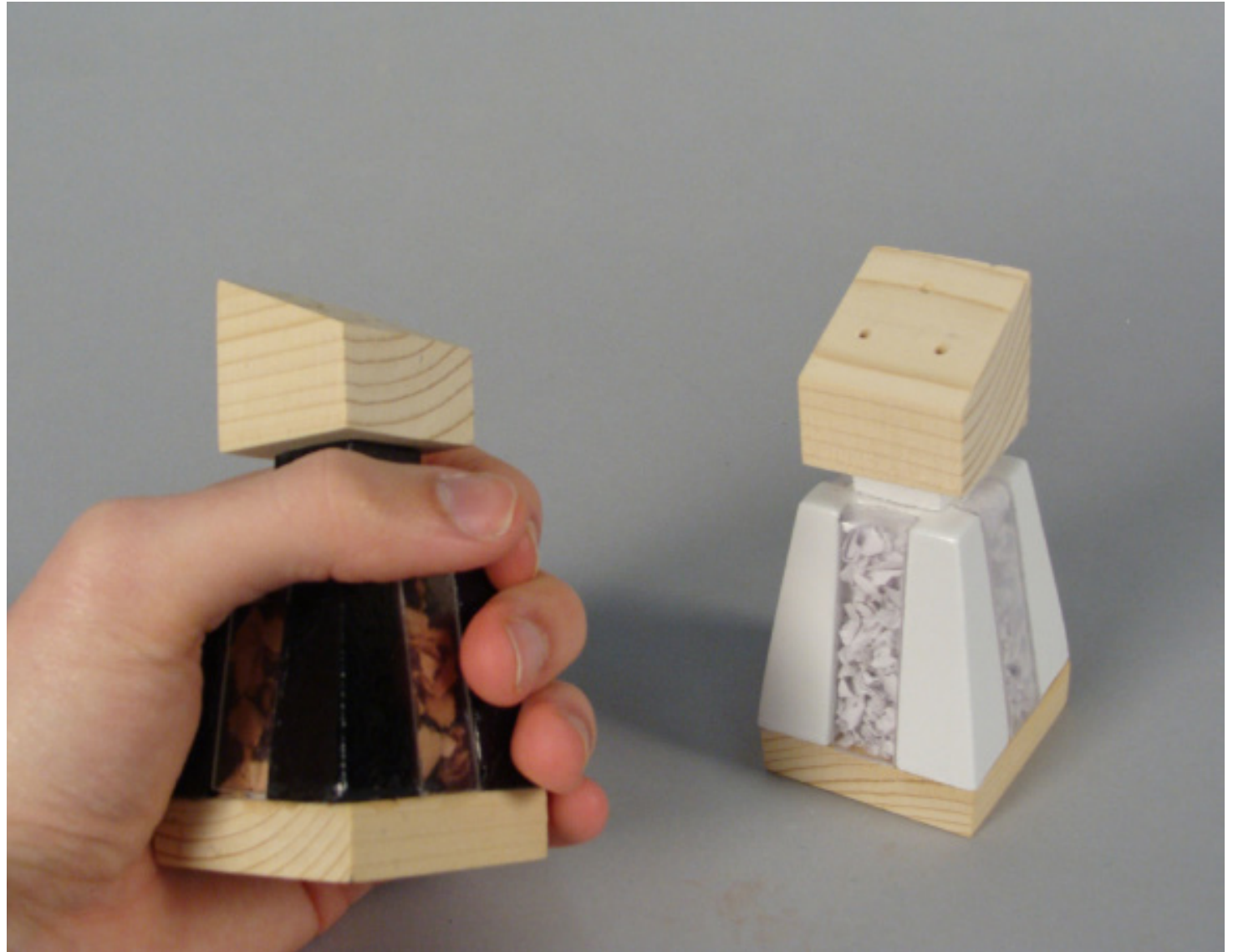

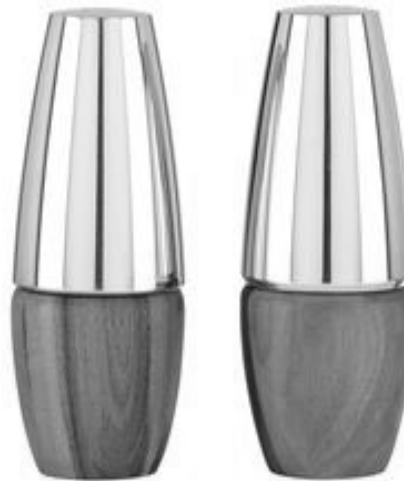
Alvar Aalto's Salt and Pepper

- Keep consumer aware of salt/pepper levels

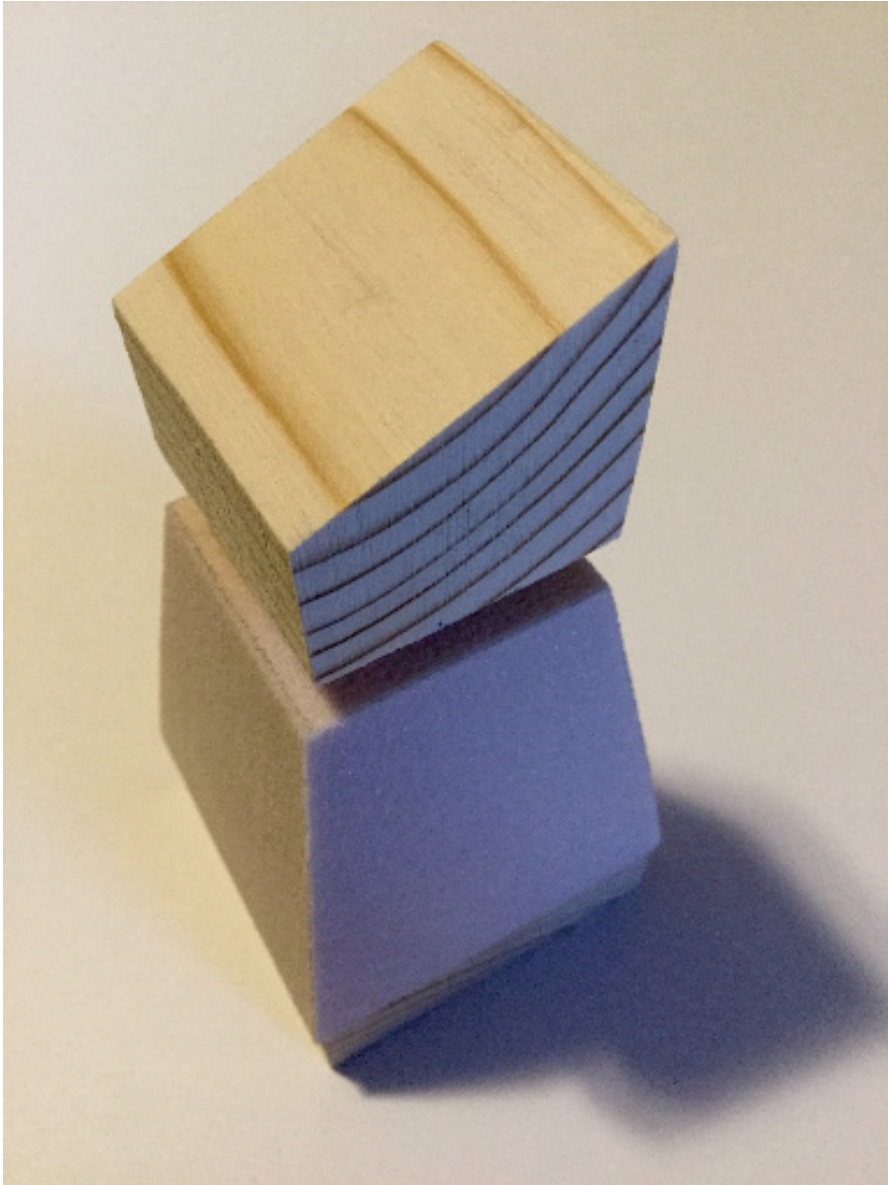

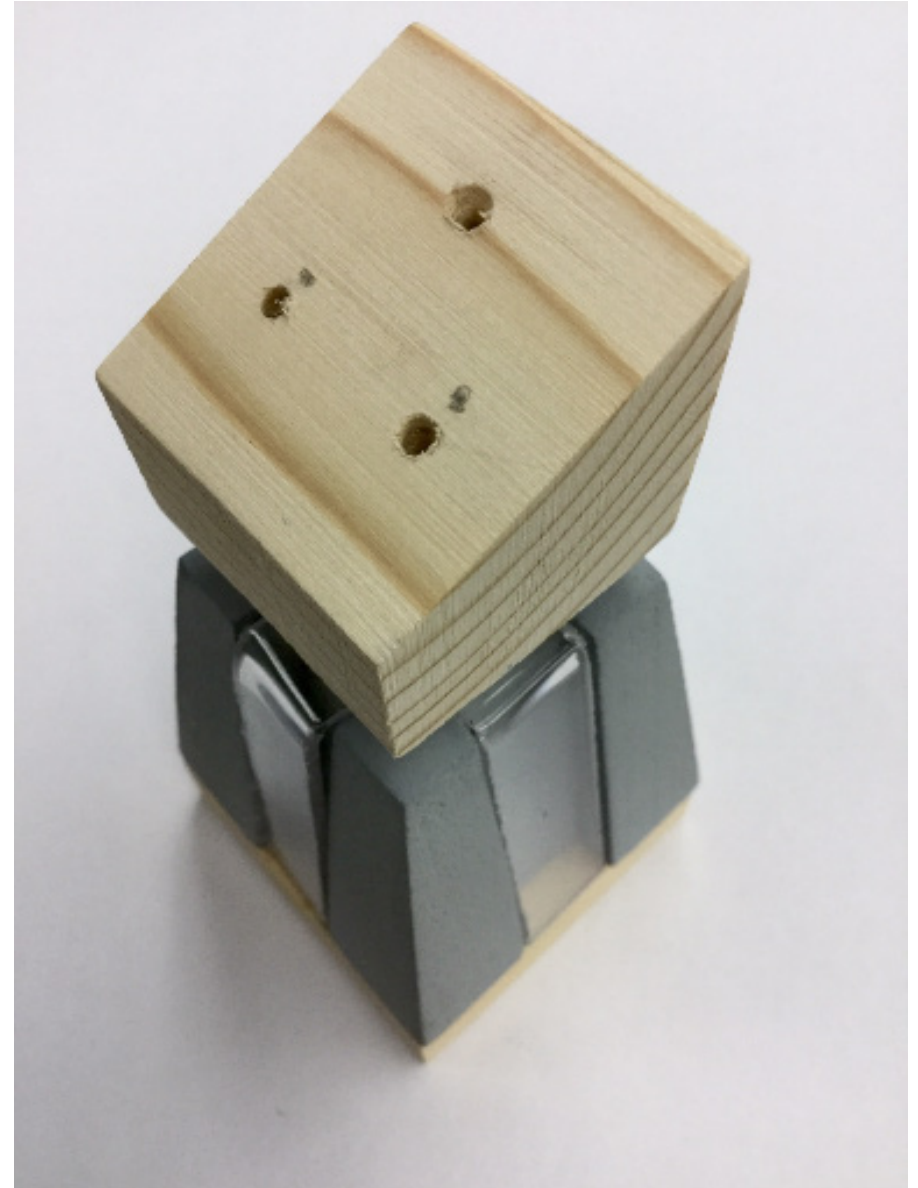

- Create a more stable base to discourage tipping

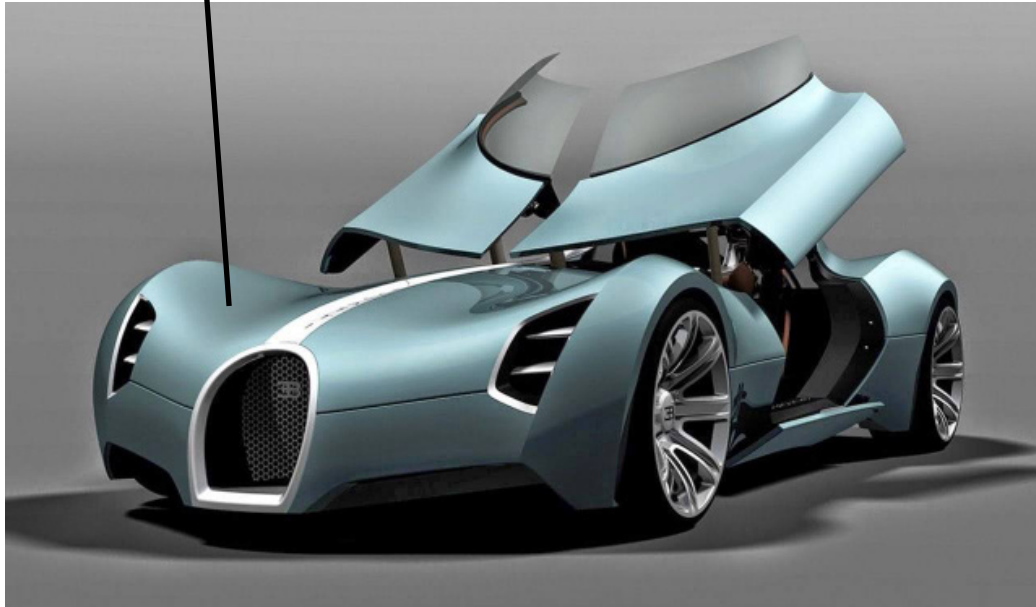
