



Rowing Tank Rules and Regulations

Words and expressions defined in the Terms shall have the same meaning in these Rowing Tank Rules and Regulations.

1. Terms and conditions for online bookings for the Rowing Tank are set out on the Website and by booking time in the Rowing Tank Participants are deemed to accept those Terms and the Rowing Tank Rules and Regulations.
2. The Rowing Tank includes the equipment therein including the tank, blades, mirrors etc.
3. All Sessions must be supervised by a suitably experienced coach. If Participants do not have access to a suitably experienced coach they must apply for one through MBC as part of the Booking. It is the coach's responsibility to supervise Participants during the Session and whilst on the Premises.
4. Participants who are 19 years or under must not be left unsupervised at any time.
5. Participants should arrive five minutes before the start of their Session in order to allow for an orderly changeover between Participants.
6. Each Participant will be responsible for leaving the tank room in a clean and tidy condition, which includes all blades not in use being hung on the racks provided.
7. Any damage to the equipment or Premises should be reported to MBC immediately. If there is no one to notify in person the damage should be reported by phone to the number displayed in the centre. Participants will be held responsible for the cost of any damage to the Rowing Centre and equipment caused by their use.
8. Any excess water on the floor around the tank should be swept down the gullies after each Session.
9. Sessions are one hour to allow time to tidy the tank room and for an orderly change over and before departure. The outgoing Participants should be off the tank at least five minutes before the expiry of the Session to allow the next group to set up.
10. The Rowing Tank is to be used for coaching technique and under no circumstances are racing starts to be practiced. This will inevitably lead to breakages and Participants will be charged for any damage caused.
11. With the exception of the changing and showering facilities, Participants are not permitted to access or use the facilities of the gym or the rest of the Rowing Centre.
12. The maximum number of persons permitted in the tank room at any time is 24.
13. No alcohol shall be permitted on the Premises.
14. MBC expects Participants to maintain good conduct whilst on its Premises or engaged in any Activities.
