IF YOU SPOT A <u>LIVE OR DEAD</u> MARINE MAMMAL STRANDED ON THE BEACH, PLEASE CONTACT ONE OF THE PEOPLE LISTED BELOW <u>AS SOON AS POSSIBLE</u>. IT IS CRUCIAL THAT A STRANDED MARINE MAMMAL BE EXAMINED SOON AFTER IT WASHES ASHORE TO ASSIST IN ITS RECOVERY. IF MAMMAL IS DECEASED, THESE SCIENTISTS NEED TO COLLECT FRESH TISSUE SAMPLES TO DETERMINE THE CAUSE OF DEATH. YOU WILL NEED TO GIVE THE RESPONSE PERSON THE EXACT TIME OF THE SIGHTHING AND A COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF THE LOCATION OF THE MARINE MAMMAL.
