Allow me to introduce Gems Robotics from the Charyl Stockwell Preparatory Academy, a small charter high school. We are a robotics team participating in the FIRST Robotics Competition, or FRC. FRC is a program designed by FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology), to inspire high school students' interest in science and technology. We are seeking sponsors to partner with us and help us accomplish this mission.

2015 was our fourth year in the FRC, and as a newer team, we have had amazing success the last two seasons. We participated in FRC tournaments where we were awarded the Motorola Quality Award and the GM Industrial Design Award. Both in 2014 and 2015 we qualified for the Michigan State Robotics Championship, where we again won the GM Industrial Design Award and placed 20<sup>th</sup> and 38<sup>th</sup> in the state, respectively. Our success at States also earned our team the opportunity to compete in the FIRST World Championship in St. Louis both years. Last spring we qualified for the playoffs at the World Championship, ultimately placing 76<sup>th</sup> of the 600 teams there! The knowledge and experience we have gained are already paying off as we continue to look to our future.

One of FIRST's goals is to promote STEM education (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) by exposing students to the world of engineering. Experienced professionals volunteer to mentor our students and guide them through the process of solving complex and challenging problems in a fun, competitive atmosphere. Students execute the entire process - the mentors are only there to guide, be supportive, and help the students with questions. This year, we want to expand our resources, reach into our community, and increase our ability to make science-related careers more accessible. However, we can't do this alone.

FIRST is effective at what it tries to accomplish, but it is expensive to participate at this level. Teams are required to learn business management and marketing skills, then seek out corporate sponsorship. It is companies such as yours that enable us to continue learning and applying the engineering skills that will shape our future.
