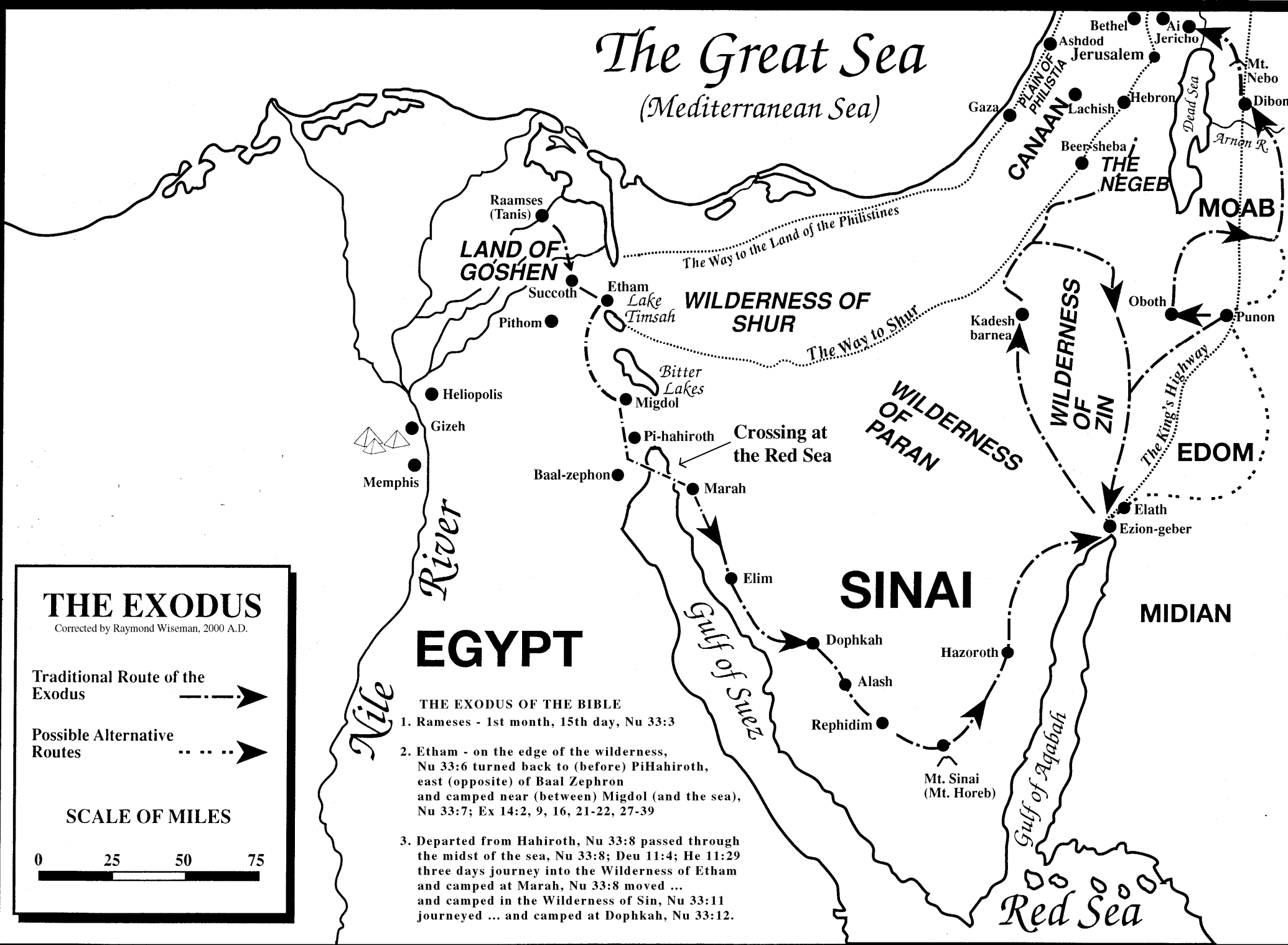


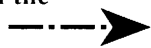

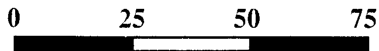
Traditional Route of the Exodus

THE EXODUS OF THE BIBLE

1. Rameses - 1st month, 15th day, Nu 33:3
2. Etham - on the edge of the wilderness, Nu 33:6 turned back to (before) PiHahiroth, east (opposite) of Baal Zephron and camped near (between) Migdol (and the sea), Nu 33:7; Ex 14:2, 9, 16, 21-22, 27-39
3. Departed from Hahiroth, Nu 33:8 passed through the midst of the sea, Nu 33:8; Deu 11:4; He 11:29 three days journey into the Wilderness of Etham and camped at Marah, Nu 33:8 moved ... and camped in the Wilderness of Sin, Nu 33:11 journeyed ... and camped at Dophkah, Nu 33:12.
