

## How to make rice bag warmers

### *Supplies*

Fabric

Scissors

Straight pins

Thread

Sewing machine

Rice (do not use instant)

Funnel

Sewing needle

### *Instructions*

- 1.** Cut two 5-inch by 10-inch pieces of fabric. Place the two squares together with the back sides of the fabric facing each other. Pin the layers together along all four sides.
- 2.** Sew along the two 10-inch side edges and on one 5-inch edge using a short straight stitch on your sewing machine and leaving a  $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch seam allowance. Sew the other 5-inch side edge but stop when you reach 2 inches from the end of the seam.
- 3.** Turn the pouch right side out.
- 4.** Pour rice through a small funnel into the bag through the gap you left in the fourth side seam. Stop when the bag is  $\frac{3}{4}$  full.
- 5.** Turn the remaining open edges to the inside of the bag and sew the gap shut by hand using a needle and thread.
